Definition of "Exonym" (Presented by Mr. Breug Austria)

Exemyms (or conventional names) are geographical names used in a certain language area for geographical entities outside that area and differing from the local official names, e.g. Milan, Venice, Vienna, Damube, Tagas for Milano, Venezia, Wien, Donau/Dunaj/Duna/Dunav/Dunārea, Tajo/Tejo.
