SUMMARY

This document describes the technical specifications of the TOPOS computerized system, including:

This paper follows up the suggestion made by Canada at the 12th meeting of the Group of Experts (Geneva, September/October 1986) that the basic technical specifications of computerized toponymic management systems of countries having such systems should be collated on the basis of a grid ensuring comparability.
