SUMMARY

Quebec's <u>Commission de toponymie</u> has been involved for some years in preparing an inventory and systematic analysis of Quebec's odonymy. Concurrently with this work, it has had to establish a process for the standardization of designations of communication routes in accordance with the methodology of analysis used in geography and, at the same time, to ensure congruous linguistic treatment, with scrupulous respect for the semantics of contemporary language and for existing cultures.
