Proposed additional terms to the glossary of technical
terminology employed in the standardization of
geographical names

- Communicative language - Official state language which is designated and used as a medium of universal communication. Some States have more than one official language
- Foreign name - Geographical name of an object situated outside the territory of a given State used in original form or in the official transcription into the Roman alphabet in case of the territory with non-Roman or ideographic writing system
- Inland name - Geographical name of an object situated in the territory of a given State
- Historical name - Geographical name of an object used in the past and differing in its form from contemporaneous standardized geographical name
- Standardization of geographical names - The process determining standard form of geographical names and its obligatory use
