Proposed additional terms to the glossary of technical terminology employed in the standardization of geographical names

Communicative language	 Official state language which is designated and used as a medium of universal communication. Some States have more than one official language
Foreign name	 Geographical name of an object situated outside the territory of a given State used in original form or in the official transcription into the Roman alphabet in case of the territory with non-Roman or ideographic writing system
Inland name	 Geographical name of an object situated in the territory of a given State
Historical name	 Geographical name of an object used in the past and differing in its form from contemporaneous standardized geographical name
Standardization of geographical names	 The process determinating standard form of geographical names and its obligatory use
