Based on Recommendation No. 35 of the 2nd UN Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names, London 1972, the Federal Republic of Germany has started the preparatory work for establishing a Gazetteer of Geographical names. Acquisition, processing and listed edition of the names shall be carried out by means of EDP. After investigations made in 1963-1972, a system analysis was worked out (see item 7, Report of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany E/CONF.61/L.19).

At first, only a selection of about 10000 names shall be compiled, so that the result of the actually planned work will lead at first to a "concise gazetteer". In spring 1975 the preface with all necessary explanations and an inventory of the German pronunciation rules shall be established.

The procedures of data acquisition are adapted to the data processing installations available in the IfAG:

Aristogrid: Digitizer with keyboard; acquisition of geometrical and alpha-numerical data.

Aristogrid ID 101: Display, digitizer, keyboard, modification of the raw data material.

Contraves CORA III: Magnetic plate, magnetic tape. High-speed printer.

Listing of the edited data material for control purposes.

The gazetteer will contain all names shown on the General Map 1:500 000 (World, Series 1404) within the borders of the Federal Republic of Germany. The coordinates are taken from the General Topographic Map 1:200 000 by means of the digitizer.

The subsequent treatment will be done in the TR 440 Computer of the GMD Darmstadt. The basic programmes are already nearly completed.

The continuous data acquisition shall start in autumn 1975. This will be proceeded by Federal States, because in some of them the administration reform is not yet finished, so that important modifications can be expected in the near future. The data acquisition of such Federal States shall be postponed to the end. The Federal Republic of Germany has the intention to present a first coherent part of the gazetteer, including the introduction, at the 3rd UN Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names, Athens 1977. According to the actual planning, the Concise Gazetteer shall be available at the end of this decade.

The enclosed sample has been edited with a high-speed printer and shows only the arrangement and size of the information given together with each name. The definitive edition will be established with EDP-controlled photo-typesetting (magnetic tape input).
