NOTE

The present bibliography on Geographical Names has been prepared to serve as a quick reference index, listing by subject and within each subject by countries of origin, the technical papers which have been presented during the past 25 years to the various UN Conferences convened under the auspices of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs.

Most of the papers were issued initially as mimeograph documents, bearing the symbol as shown in this bibliography; however, these papers are, for the most part, no longer available in this form and have been grouped and published in printed editions of "Report" or "Proceedings" of the conference for which they have been prepared. The list of conferences for which papers are included in this bibliography is given in annex.
