1. National committee on Geographical Names:

The National committee on Geographical Names was reformed to include representatives from 8 authorities that are directly related with Geographical names. A pamphlet related with the committee's works, duties, meetings and mechanism was prepared. This committee is the only authority in Jordan concerned with any thing related with Geographical names such as giving new names, changing present names or writhing names in Roman and Arabic letters.

2. Jordan and the world Atlas :

This Atlas was issued in 2002. It contains maps and information about Jordan, Arab countries, the world, continents and oceans. Geographical names were written according to the recommendations of the UN experts conferences on Geographical names and according to available references

3. Jordanian School Atlas/ English :

This Atlas was issued in 2001. It contains maps and information about Jordan, Arab countries, the world and continents. Arabic Names were written in Roman letters according to Romanization System, non- Arabic Names according to modern available references.

4. Jordanian building Centres which its names were changed :

A list of building centres names in Jordan was prepared to include the present and the previous names.

5. A administrative divisions in Jordan:

A modern administrative divisions for Jordan were issued in 17/9/2000, it include details about governorates and new districts.

National Committee On Geographical Names / Jordan

- **Definitions :**

- Committee : National Committee on Geographical Names.
- Geographical Names : Names of towns, streets, geographic sites and Landmarks.
- Headquarter :Royal Jordanian Geographic Centre.
- President : Head of the National Committee on Geographical Names.
- Deputy : Deputy president of the National Committee on Geographical Names.
- Secretary : Secretary of the National Committee on Geographical Names.

- **Members :**

- 1) Representative of Ministry of Awqaf.
- 2) Representative of Ministry of Interior.
- 3) Representative of Ministry of Municipalities, Rural Affairs and Environment.
- 4) Representative of Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities.
- 5) Representative of Department of lands and Survey.
- 6) Representative of Arabic Language Academy.
- 7) Representative of the Royal Jordanian Geographic Centre.
- 8) Representative of Greater Amman Municipality.
- 9) Members of both public and private sectors upon the consent of prime Ministry.

- **President of the Committee:**

General Director of Royal Jordanian Geographic Centre.

- **Duties of the president :**

- 1) To supervise all the committee's works and activities.
- 2) To be the president of the committee and invite for its meetings.

- **Duties of Deputy President:**

- 1) To handle the works entitled to him by the president.
- 2) To represent the president during his absence.

- **Duties the Secretary :**
 - 1) To write down the committee's sessions.
 - 2) To supervise the records keeping and organization.
 - 3) To follow up executing the committee's decisions.
 - 4) To prepare for the committee's meetings.

- **Duties of the committee:**
 - 1) To unify Geographical Names writing in Jordan.
 - 2) To perpetuate and publish Jordanian Geographical Names Index.
 - 3) To nominate the proposed and substitute names for the Prime Ministry
 - 4) To approve the system of writing names in Roman letters or non – Arabic names in Arabic letters according the system approved by the United Nations.
 - 5) To provide a data base for substitute or new names includes historical events, martyrs, political and literary personalities that have distinguished role in social life.
 - 6) To follow up new events in Arab countries related to Geographical Names.

- **Authorities of the committee:**
 - 1) To get help from any appropriate experts and specialists in both Public and Private sectors.
 - 2) To cancel or stop using any new names until it be licensed by the committee.
 - 3) To publish articles, researches, studies and books, held conferences and fairs, posters, get use of audio – visual media to identify the duties of the committee and its works in the field of Geographical Names.
 - 4) To make field and research studies when necessary.
 - 5) To recommend new members (institutions or individuals) or substitute working members with others upon the consent of the Prime Ministry.

- **Mechanism of the Committee:**
 - 1) The committee shall consider in its periodical or urgent meetings, the applications and documents referred to it concerned changing Geographical Names or giving new names.
 - 2) To choose new names depending on the bases adopted by the committee.

- 3) To refer the new proposed names to the Prime Ministry to take required measures according to the related rules and regulations.

- **General bases for new names :**

- 1) The name should not be repeated.
- 2) It must not hurt the national or religious feelings.
- 3) It must not cause political racial, religious or tribal sensitivity.
- 4) It shouldn't be related with a name of tribe, family or person unharmonized with the committee's duties.
- 5) It should be related with the culture of Jordan and both Arab and Islamic worlds.
- 6) These matters should be taken into consideration when giving new names for certain positions :
Consult the inhabitants of the area, agree with them as possible about the new names so that it can't be contradicted with principles approved by the committee.
- 7) To be acquainted with the geographical phase of the position.
- 8) To fix the suitable syllable of the name if it contains more than one syllable.
- 9) To look in the Geographical Names bank of the committee to choose the suitable name.
- 10) To make the letters in eloquence language.
- 11) To pronounce the name correctly.

- **The Committees Meeting :**

- 1) The committee hold its meeting periodically every month, urgent meetings shall be held if necessary.
- 2) The meeting is considered legal if half the members + one are present.
- 3) The committee's decisions are adopted by voting, If they are equal the vote of president or his deputy settle the question.
- 4) The committee holds its meetings in its headquarter, or any other position according to the nature of the work.

Jordanian School Atlas

The Royal Jordanian Geographic Centre produced this Atlas in 2001. It contains 96 pages including 87 map page, 5 pages information tables about the countries of the world includes: capital, area, population, currency and individual income according to the recent available information.

This Atlas consists of 14 maps about Jordan, 33 maps about Arab countries and world maps for continents, world and oceans.

The Romanization system, which is adopted in R.J.G.C and other Arab countries was used in this Atlas concerning the Arabic names with assuring on correct spelling. Names of other non - Arab countries were written - as possible - according to available publications by these countries, or using different references of Roman Letters.

This Atlas may contain some notes, we hope to amend any names may change or be provided by official writing issued by the country itself in future editions, knowing that the name is written in the same way in all maps.
