SUMMARY

The *Instituto Geográfico Nacional* (IGN) has carried out a list of European capitals and cities greater than 100 000 inhabitants, including the Spanish exonyms that the IGN use in its own cartography. Data base content is described on this paper.

The IGN has followed the recommendation of United Nations about the advisability of reducing as much as possible the use of exonyms in the international field.
