Process




- Gathering names

Disseminating the data

- Names are important to communication
- Maps, reports, etc. need up-to-date names
- Must distribute names data ... don't be "best kept secret"!
- Different ways of doing this






Who needs to know?


- Public understand and appreciate the history and meaning of the names
 - Informed through data access, internet, media, the news, brochures, presentations, displays
- Government generally less interested in the history and meaning!
 - Informing management for decisionmaking through maps, gazetteers, databases

Gazetteers

- Reference listings of geographical names, usually arranged alphabetically, and including various attributes
 - Gazetteer indexes to atlases
 - Geographical dictionaries
 - Gazetteers for maps of particular scale
 - Concise national gazetteers
 - Special gazetteers (e.g. N. Quebec, Canada)
 - On-line gazetteers/databases



- some 10,000 names for ~7800 locations
 - enhance knowledge and preserve culture
