Arabic-language version of the resolutions adopted at the first to tenth United Nations Conferences on the Standardization of Geographical Names

Summary**

Following the Tenth United Nations Conference on the Standardization of Geographical Names and for the purpose of disseminating knowledge and information on the resolutions adopted at the United Nations Conferences on the Standardization of Geographical Names to Arabic-speaking Member States, the Working Group on Evaluation and Implementation under the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names and the National Geographic Information Institute, Republic of Korea, coordinated their efforts to translate the document prepared by Natural Resources Canada entitled "Resolutions adopted at the ten United Nations Conferences on the Standardization of Geographical Names 1967, 1972, 1977, 1982, 1987, 1992, 1998, 2002, 2007, 2012". The aim was also to create a searchable database in Arabic for those resolutions, similar to the database established by the Group of Experts and available on its website.²

The references used in preparing the translation of the document were the Glossary of Terms for the Standardization of Geographical Names,³ and Arabiclanguage versions of the reports of the Eighth, Ninth and Tenth Conferences on the

Standardization of Geographical Names⁴ and the Manual for the National Standardization of Geographical Names.⁵

The Arabic-language version of the document (E/CONF.105/6/CRP.6, annex) has been submitted to the secretariat of the Group of Experts and the Arab Division of Experts on Geographical Names for their consideration and for dissemination on the website of the Group of Experts⁶ and of the Arab Division.⁷

It is hoped that the Arabic-language version of the document and the upcoming Arabic searchable database for resolutions will serve as valuable references for experts from Arab Member States on the resolutions adopted by the Conferences.
