## **Updating of Toponymic guidelines for map editors and other editors – Finland**

The 4<sup>th</sup>, revised edition of *Toponymic guidelines for map editors and other editors – Finland*, presented at the 22<sup>nd</sup> session of UNGEGN, New York, 2004 (WP 49), has been updated (version 4.9 May 2017).

The updates concern, e.g., the distribution of population and languages in Finland (section 1 *Languages*), the list of publications (section 3 *Publications*), information on a proposal for a place names act in Finland, and changes in the number and names of the municipalities since 2016.

The list of the names of Finnish municipalities (list 1) has been updated according to the situation in the beginning of 2017.
