## THE NAMES OF FEATURES BEYOND A SINGLE SOVEREIGNTY

From time to time it becomes apparent that there is some misunderstanding over the resolutions passed at conferences concerning features beyond a single sovereignty. The resolutions deal with features shared by two or more sovereignties and also features which are beyond any given sovereignty.

Resolutions I/8A; II/25; II/34; III/20; V/25 refer to shared sovereignty.

Resolutions 1/8B; II/24; II/26; and II/34 refer to features over which there is no possible sovereignty.

Several of the resolutions need to be combined into a single resolution at the Seventh Conference, making the distinction between shared sovereignty and absence of sovereignty.
