Background

The online discussion forum is an activity supported by the Working Group on Toponymic on Data Files and Gazetteers. The forum is a wiki tool used for the exchange of information about several issues related to UNGEGN. It has been regularly updated since 2017 and comprises the following topics:

This online discussion forum shall be utilized to commence investigations on these issues mentioned before within the WG TDFG. Therefore, separate Wiki “rooms” / pages for these specific topics have been created and initial documents were uploaded to it.

All users can see/view all content of the online discussion forum even without being registered. Registered members are able to start to comment on the initial documents and extend the content of the Wiki “rooms” / pages respectively.

Objectives

The workshop shall identify the advantages and disadvantages of the tool and lead to a decision whether or not this activity should be further supported by the Working Group on Toponymic on Data Files and Gazetteers. It is obvious that tackling these new and quite complex issues needs a strong support and contributions by the UNGEGN members. They have been asked to provide content and initial documents. Currently the interest to contribute to the issues via the online discussion forum is weak. One reason might be that the user-friendliness of the tool has not yet been clarified satisfactorily. Another reason might be that the tool has not convinced the users to be appropriate for improving the exchange of ideas within UNGEGN significantly.

Activity

The convenor of the WG TDFG as well as the responsible moderators of the respective fora will present the content, the challenges and opportunities of the tool. Based on these presentations an open discussion will take place and shall lead to general decision about the usefulness of the online discussion forum for UNGEGN issues.
