South African: Appointment of the South African Geographical Names Council

The Minister of Arts and Culture appointed the new South African Geographical Names Council(SAGNC) because the three year term of the council had expied in October 2010. As required by the South African Geographical Names Act, the Minister in consultation with the SAGNC appointed a new Chairperson.

The past year saw the SAGNC recommending to the Minister standardization of some geographical feature and mostly the correction of spelling for a number of geographical features in the KwaZulu Natal Province and change of geographical names feature in Mpumalanga Province (see the list of approved names).
