- I. In names of strongly established historical forms, the digraph av will be written as au in lieu of av.
2. In names of strongly established historical forms, the letter β will be written as b in lieu of v.
3. In names of strongly established historical forms, the digraph εv will be written as eu in lieu of ev.
4. In a small number of names of strongly established historical forms (to be decided by a special committee), the letter ɛ will be written as e in lieu of i.
5. In names of strongly established forms, the letter φ will be written as ph in lieu of f.
6. The apostrophe and reversed apostrophe are omitted. In a small number of names of strongly established forms, the reversed

apostrophe will be maintained as h.

7. Accents will be used to denote the accented syllables, except in one-syllable words and words accented on the last syllable. In accented digraphs, the accent will be placed on the second vowel.
8. The diaeresis will be shown with " in names where two consecutive vowels appear as a diphthong.
9. Double consonants will be maintained.
