Rio de Janeiro, Brazil 1 May 2017 This information has been compiled to assist you in preparation for your travel to Brazil to participate in the UNGEGN International Course in Toponymy. The course is coordinated by the United Nations, Department of Economic and Social Affairs, Statistics Division, UNGEGN in collaboration with the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics, Reference Centre for Geographical Names.

About the Course:

The Toponymy training course is being done to support capacity building for members of the UNGEGN Portuguese-speaking and Latin America Divisions responsible for the standardization of geographical names. The objective of the course is to increase knowledge and understanding of the principles and concepts of geographical naming and the standardization of a country's toponyms; transfer methods and best practices in geographical names data collection; toponymic database building, the design and development of gazetteers, geographical names servers and cartographic applications

On completion, course participants will be asked to complete an evaluation form and will receive a certificate of participation.

Working Language of Course

The course will be delivered in English. Spanish translation will be provided for the field trip.

Teaching Method

Course will be delivered by lectures, demonstrations, discussions, practical exercises, and field work. Course material includes on-line manuals and documents, and power point presentations.

Lunch

Course participants will be responsible for their own lunch. There are several restaurants in the surroundings of the course venue. Participants will receive a map of the area showing the restaurants and shopping and banking facilities.

Coffee Breaks

Coffee breaks will be offered in the morning and in the afternoon.

General Information

Visa requirements

Visitors are advised to contact Brazilian embassies or consulates on visa requirements and obtain the appropriate entry permit where necessary as early as possible.

Vaccination

Visitors may need to get a vaccine before visiting Brazil. They are advised to see their health care provider at least four weeks before traveling.

VERY IMPORTANT:

We strongly recommend those who have not yet been vaccinated against yellow fever to do so at least 10 days before their arrival in Rio. There have been a few cases of this disease in the country and the government is vaccinating the population of some States, including Rio de Janeiro.

Airport and Transportation

Galeão/Antônio Carlos Jobim International Airport: Phone: +55 21 3004-6050, located in Ilha do Governador, Rio de Janeiro – RJ, about 20 km from downtown. The service of special taxis is recommended from the airport to the hotel. Vouchers may be purchased at the taxi stands in the Galeão/Antônio Carlos Jobim International Airport in the arrival area. Only credit cards or reais are accepted.

Santos Dumont Domestic Airport: Phone: +55 21 3814-7070. Located at Praça Senador Salgado Filho, about 2km from downtown Rio. The service of special taxis is recommended from the airport to the hotel. Vouchers may be purchased at the taxi stands in the arrival area.

Weather

The Symposium will be held in May, during the autumn of the Southern hemisphere. In this time of the year, the weather is sunny, with temperatures ranging from 23° to 32° C (73,4° to 89,6° F).

Money exchange

Visitors may bring foreign currency or traveler checks, which may be exchanged into local currency, the Real. International credit cards are generally accepted. Currency exchange is available at the airports and in some hotels.

Electric system

Standard voltage in Rio de Janeiro is 110V. The three-pin plug has recently been adopted as standard, but several formats can still be found.
