Geographical names used in a certain language for

**geographical entities situated outside the area
where that language has official status**

and

**differing in its form from the name used in the official language of the area where the
geographical entity is situated. (2nd UNCSGN1972).**

What kind of objects generates exonyms?

- Objects in areas close to linguistic borders,
- Important objects further from linguistic border (names of countries, capitals, large rivers).
