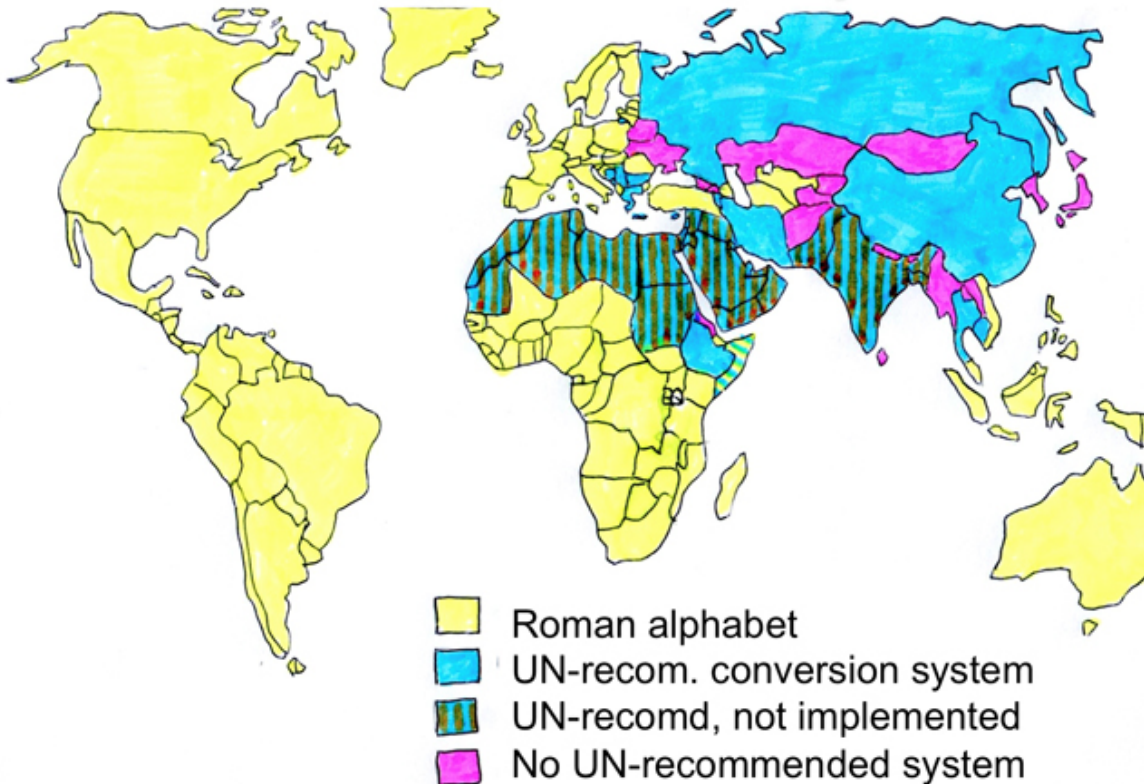




UN romanization systems
