Initiatives aiming at building statistical capacity



- Training workshops and advisory missions on gender statistics: GA-DA Project
 - UNSD, UN reg. commissions, UNEP, UNODC
 - Focus on: VAW; TUS; users-producers dialogue; better use of existing data;
- Labour Market Statistics Academy and related training programmes
 - ILO - Annually since 2015
 - Focus on: labour market statistics, including dedicated elements on gender mainstreaming in labour statistics
- SDG Capacity Development workshops-annually in each region=
 - UNFPA, Focus on: Goal 3 and 5
- Roll out of national, sub-regional and regional workshops; develop an e-learning course = FAO; Focus on Goal 2 and 5
- Regular global and regional workshops on implementation of UNW initiative = UNW
 - Focus on: ?
