**EA2**: Developing/refining methods to produce gender data

- Training workshops on statistics and indicators to measure VAW and time use, in particular unpaid domestic and care work
  - Regular meetings on producing VAW and TUS

- Technical assistance missions to support the production of statistics on VAW and time use
  - National meetings, technical assistance missions on producing VAW, TUS, environment


**1,272** participants trained in the production, communication and use of gender statistics (67% women)



Overall better coordination among UN gender statistics implementing entities – shared vision and joint development of work plan and coordinated implementation



Partnerships established/strengthened – UNEP (new to gender data work); ILO, WHO, UN Women (critical in success of many activities); many donor countries (Finland, Japan)



Improved integration of the gender perspective within the implementing entities' work programmes – in addition to DA10's stand-alone gender statistics component
