- Developing the minimum set of Indicators for Gender Statistics— Work by the IAEG sub-group on Databases and Indicators
- **UNSC** endorsement of list of indicators
- **Next steps:** 
  - International data compilation of indicators on Tier 1
  - Promoting capacity building activities for indicators in Tier 2
  - Methodological development for indicators in Tier 3



- Gender Statistics Manual
  - First draft will be completed by end of 2011
  - ►EGM to review and discuss draft June 2012
- Violence against women
  - Guidelines were completed and will be reviewed at EGM in Beirut in November 2011



UNSC 2011 as part of the implementation of

- Assisting countries in integrating a gender perspective into their national statistical
  - ► Technical assistance
  - Advisory services
  - >Training
- Production and use of audio-visual materials and use of ICT for training
  - ► Work can build on existing tools developed by WB, ECE and ECLAC



requested by UNSC as part of implementation of

- Review coordinated by UNSD and implemented by regional commissions, based on a common questionnaire
- UNSD to compile and produce a synthesis of regional
- UNSD to propose examples of best practices for gender statistics programmes to be agreed by IAEG and used by countries as a reference/guide



Strengthen the role of the IAEG-GS (as requested by UNSC 2011)

- Periodically identify gaps, complementarities and areas where the gains and synergies in gender statistics programme activities and outputs can be consolidated
- IAEG-GS to meet annually to review the state of development in the field of gender statistics
- 6th IAEG Meeting in Amman, Jordan April 2012

  Global Forum on Gender Statistics be convened biennially as a forum for the sharing of experiences
- UNSD and IAEG to report back to the Commission on their proposed work plans and strategies to strengthen the global gender statistics programme



Donor community to increase funding (as requested by UNSC 2011)
