## Main Points

- 2001 – First step (cooperation, data collection)
- 2003 - Department for the Gender Statistics
- 2003 – Women and Men in Data
- 2005 – Gender conception adopted
- 2005 – Press Conference about some myths in Gender problems (average, median, GPG)
- 2006 – Gender Websites
- 2006 – Focus on Women and Men (analytical text)



## Present issues

- Women and Men in data 2011 (time series, new information in the field of Health, Social care or Justice and Crime)
- Focus on Women and Men 2011 (since 2009 on Internet only)
- Cooperation with the UNECE and the Working Group on the EU Gender Equality Index



## Data Collection

- Recommended indicators by UN ECE (no problem, 7 areas + Social care)
- Comparability of data (methodological problems)
- Source of Data (LFSS, EU-SILC, Housing census, government departments, IHIS CR, IIE CR, Structural wage statistics, websites, other)
- No money for Time Surveys



## Publication (analysis)

- Yearbooks (Focus on Women and Men)
- Women and Men in Data
- Ad-hoc gender analysis (Women and Men in the Information society, in various types of households, Gender aspects of Foreigners in the CR)
- Analytical text of the Yearbook (Life of Women and Men – since 2006)

## Main Areas and Data Sources

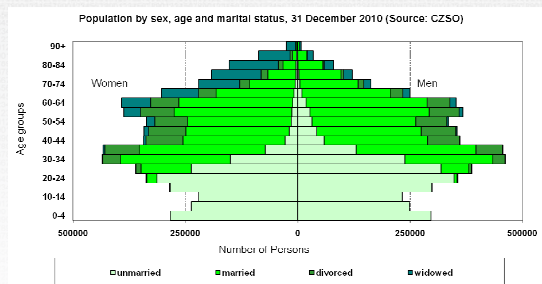
- 1. Population (Census, EU – SILC, LFSS, Dem. Stat.)

- 4. Labour and Wages (LFSS,
- 5. Social security (this is special chapter in the CR, MLSA CR)
- 6. Justice and Crime (Ministry of Justice, The Police Presidium)
- 7. Public Life (Ministries, Election Statistics of the CZSO)
- 8. Science, technology and the Information Society (CZSO, Sample Surveys)



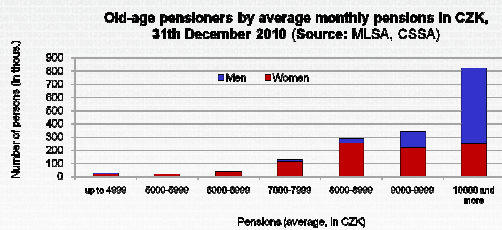
