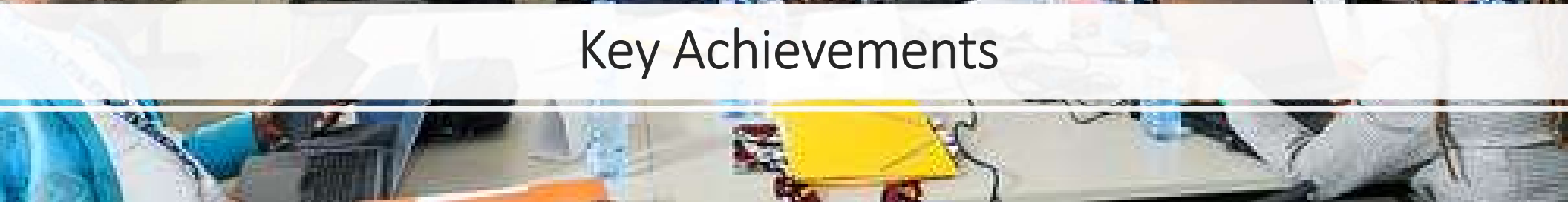

- The evaluation report gives an overview of the achievements and challenges experienced during the implementation of the APGS with concrete recommendations on a way forward for the next phase of the APGS.
- This includes the functioning of coordination mechanisms governing the implementation of the APGS, including interagency cooperation/partnership, AGGS, and its core groups.
- The findings were also used amongst others, to inform the development of phase III of the APGS.

- Provides strategic direction and scope for the actors in the gender data ecosystem to *strengthen institutions, improve coordination mechanisms, update legislation, ensure adequate budgetary allocations, advance research, and methodological development, and improve staff competencies and data sources.*
- It will continue to support member states to develop and integrate gender statistics programming in their respective countries

## **1 - GDN**

- PARIS21 became the global secretariat for the GDN & GDN expands to new countries in Africa: Initially, the Network was containing 15 African member States, and in 2022 an expansion has made through including 7 additional countries.

## **2 - UNDA 12th**

- ECA adapted UNTACD Gender Sensitive Trade Statistics framework to African context
- Development of statistical guidelines for the compilation of trade and gender statistics
- *Assessment of data gaps and data need in gender related trade statistics*
- *Development of national Action Plan for the improvement of gender related trade statistics.*
