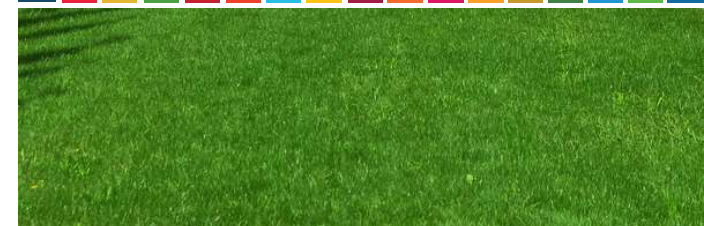

- Assessment & inventory of data sources
- Microdata linking
- Indicators produced include:
 - ✓ Share of female employment in exporting sectors
 - ✓ Ratios of women-to-men wages in exporting sectors
 - ✓ Ratio of women-to-men employment in trading companies
 - ✓ Gender pay gap in trading companies
 - ✓ Ownership of trading companies by gender

CES Census Recommendations for the 2030 round



Task Force on **Sex and Gender** to update section on sex

Scope

- Definition of sex for the purposes of the census
- Rationale for sex as a core topic
- Recommendations for countries that are introducing gender or more than two response options for sex
 - Testing, question wording, response categories
 - Issues to consider for changes to census: policy need, public opinion, legal context, disclosure control and quality assurance
