Global Survey on Gender Stats last conducted in 2012 with 126 responses

Main objectives of the 2022 survey

measure progress in production and use of gender statistics in countries since 2012

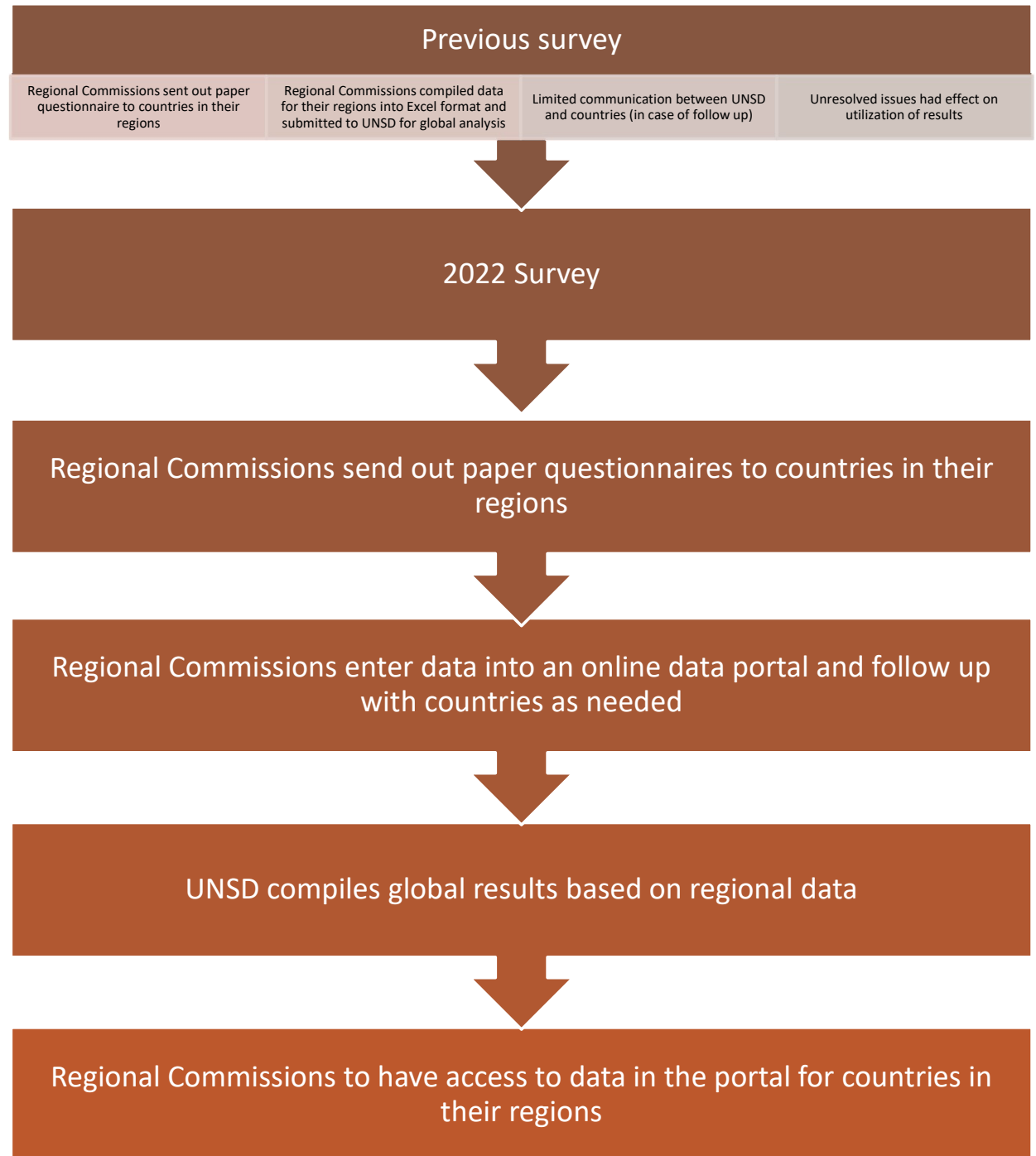
assess the impact of COVID-19 pandemic on production of gender statistics;

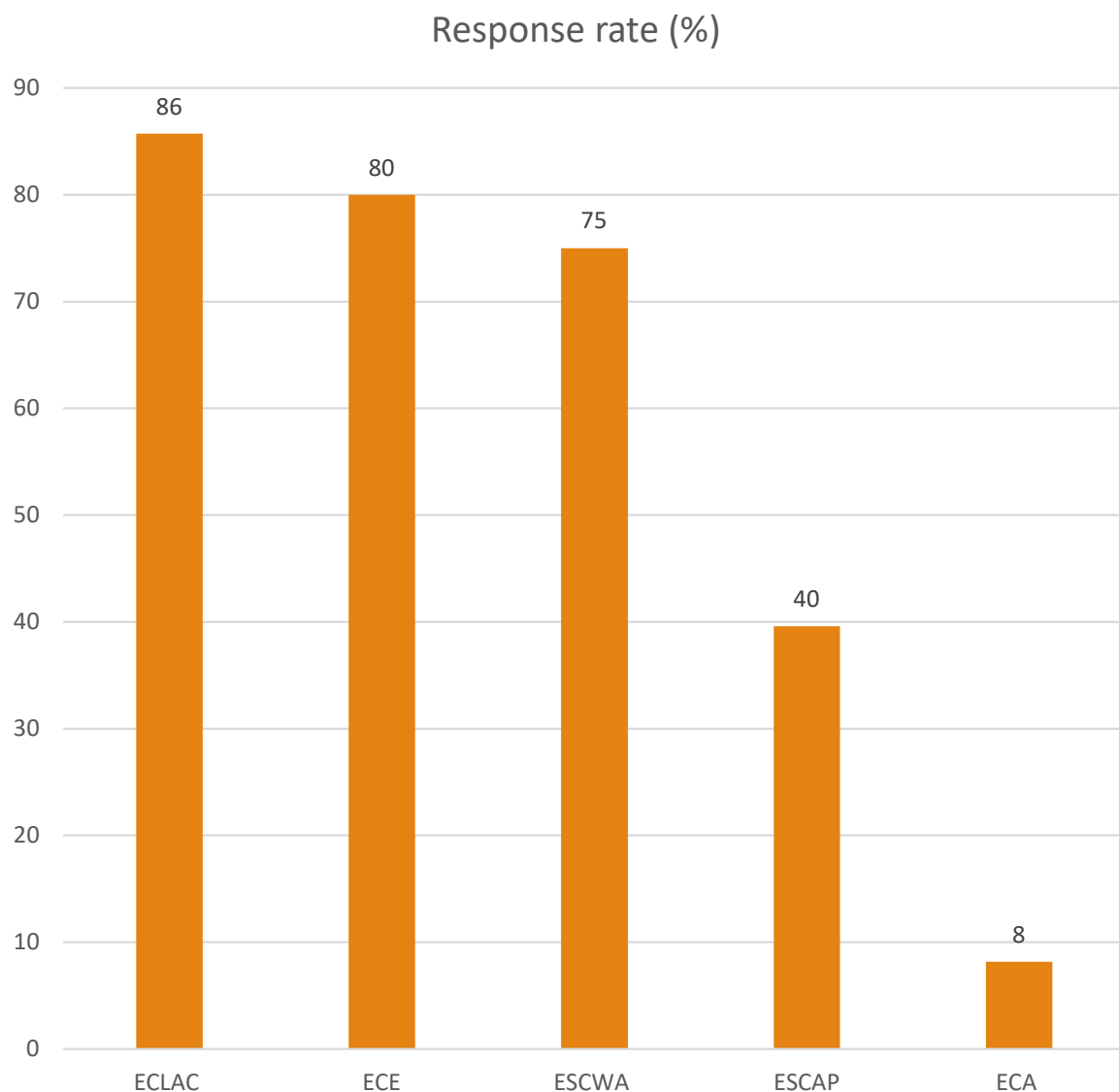
obtain information on whether and how a gender perspective is mainstreamed into national statistical systems;

assess relevance and impact of work of United Nations and partners;

# 2022 Survey on Gender Statistics vs previous survey



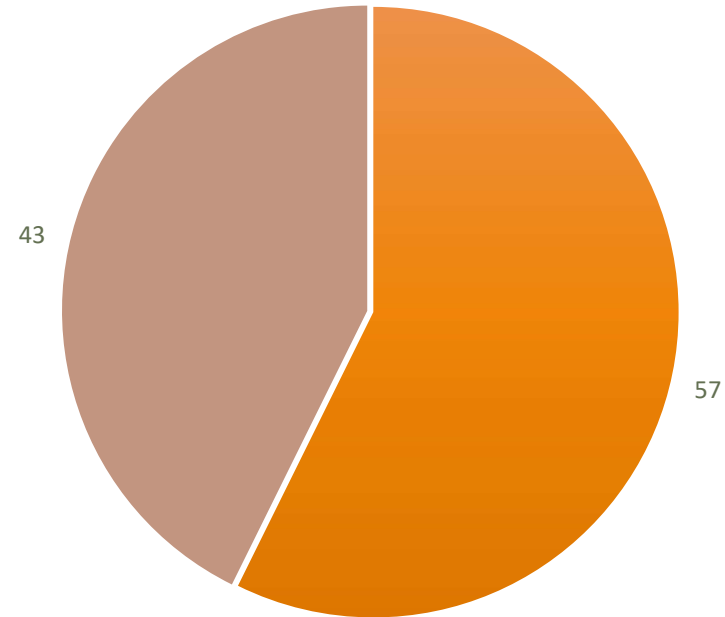

# Organizational setting for gender statistics entity

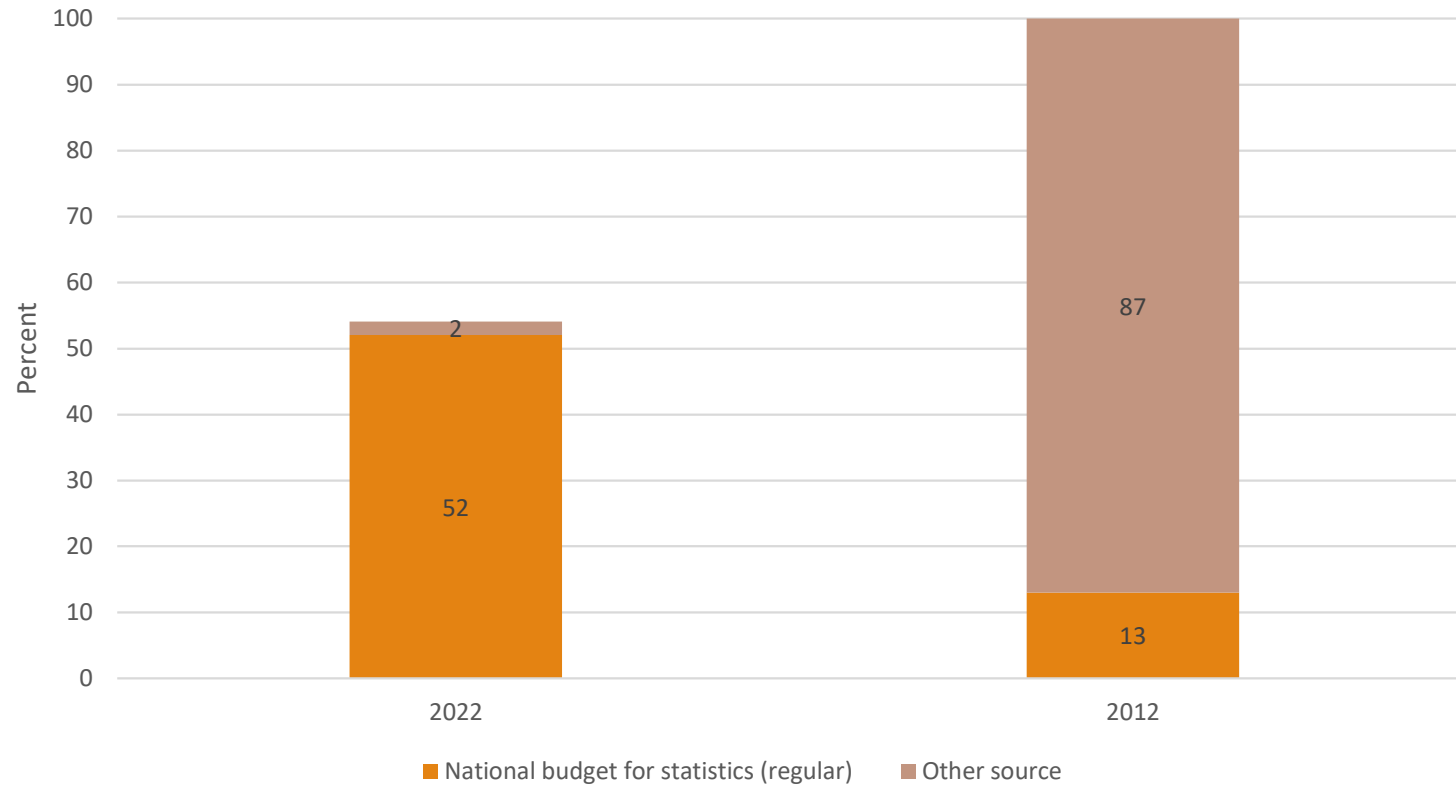

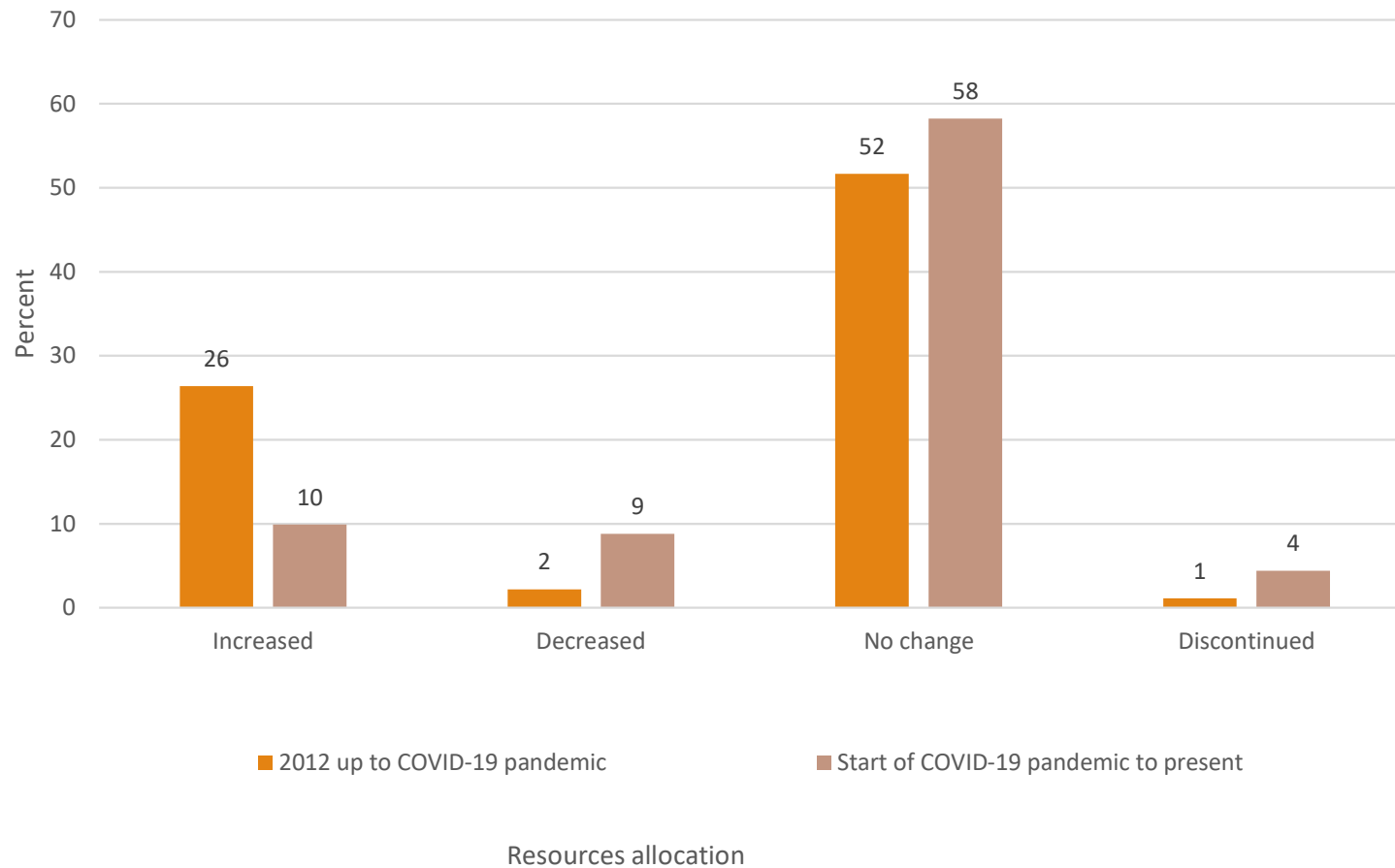


■ Gender entity within NSO ■ Gender entity outside NSO

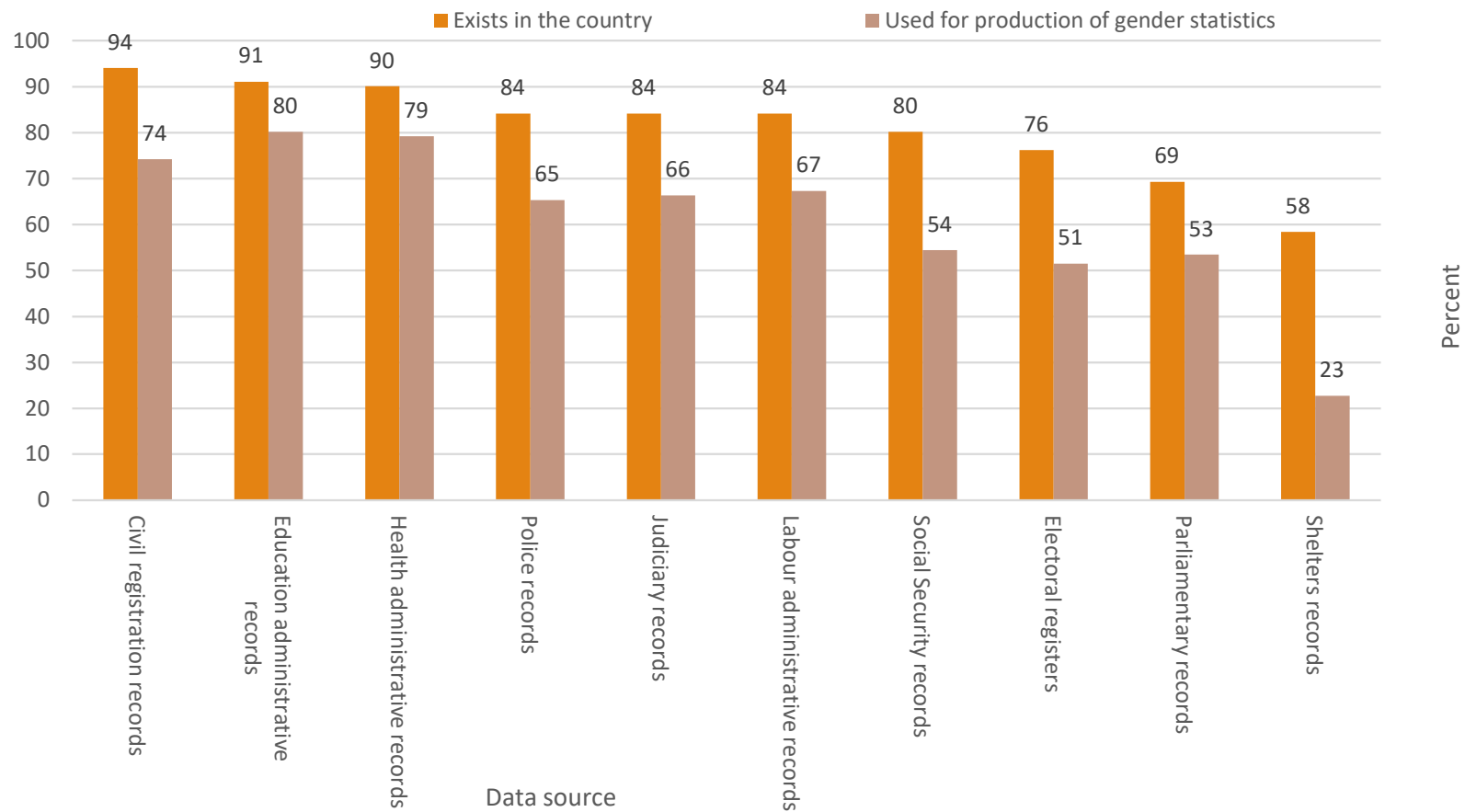
# Main source of funding for gender statistics in the NSOs



# Resources allocation for gender statistics in the NSO

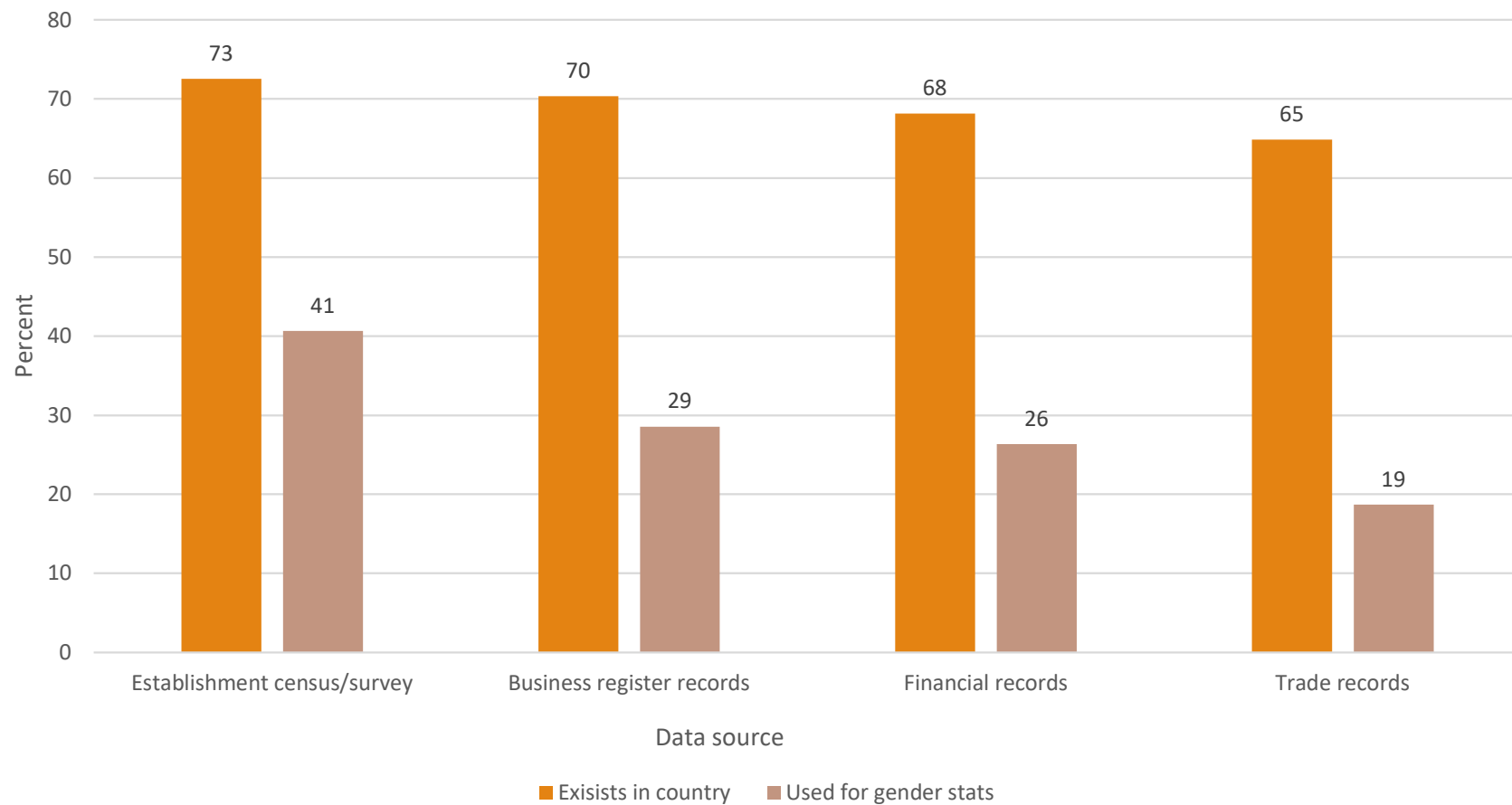


# Administrative data sources and use for gender statistics

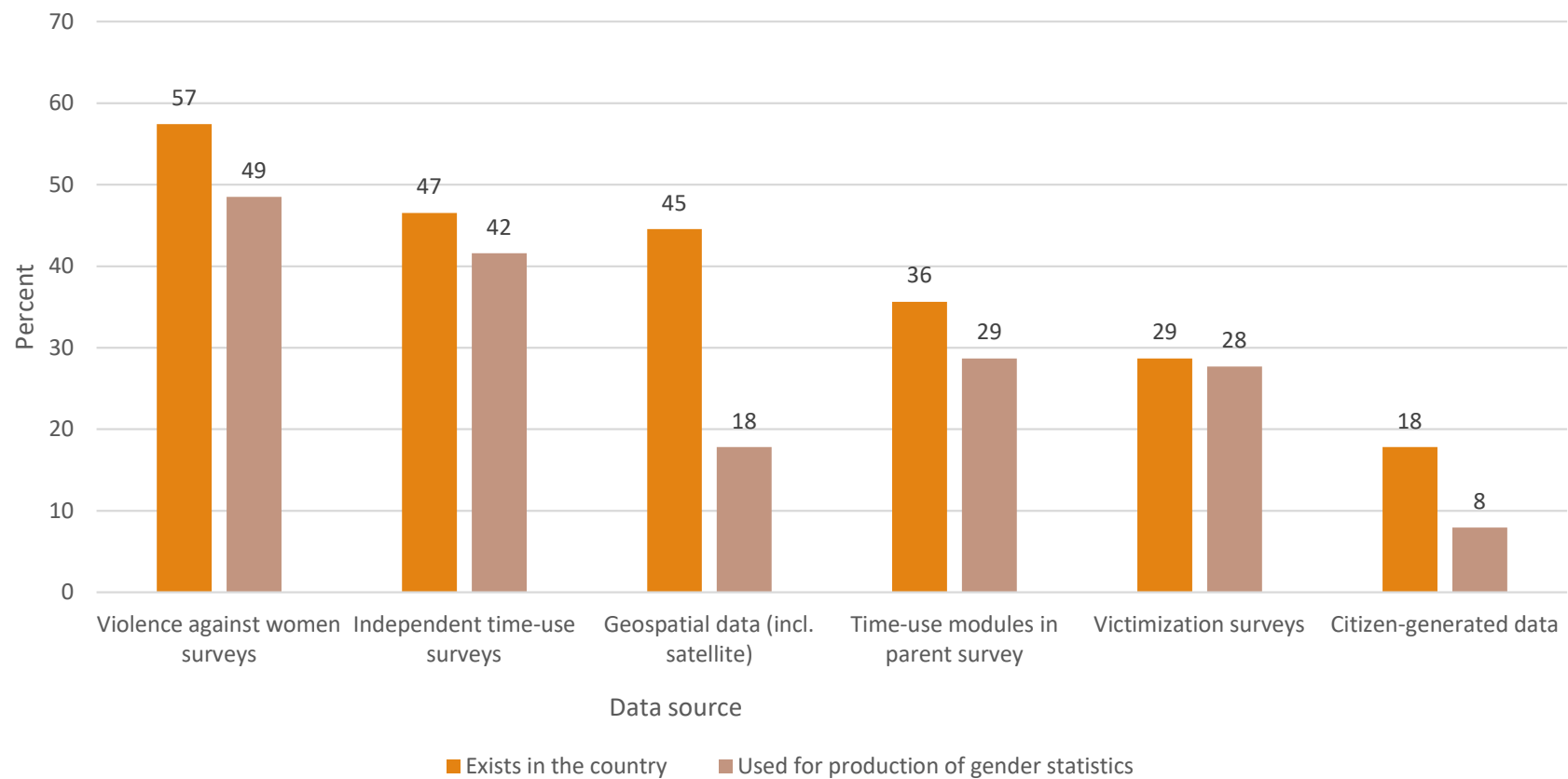




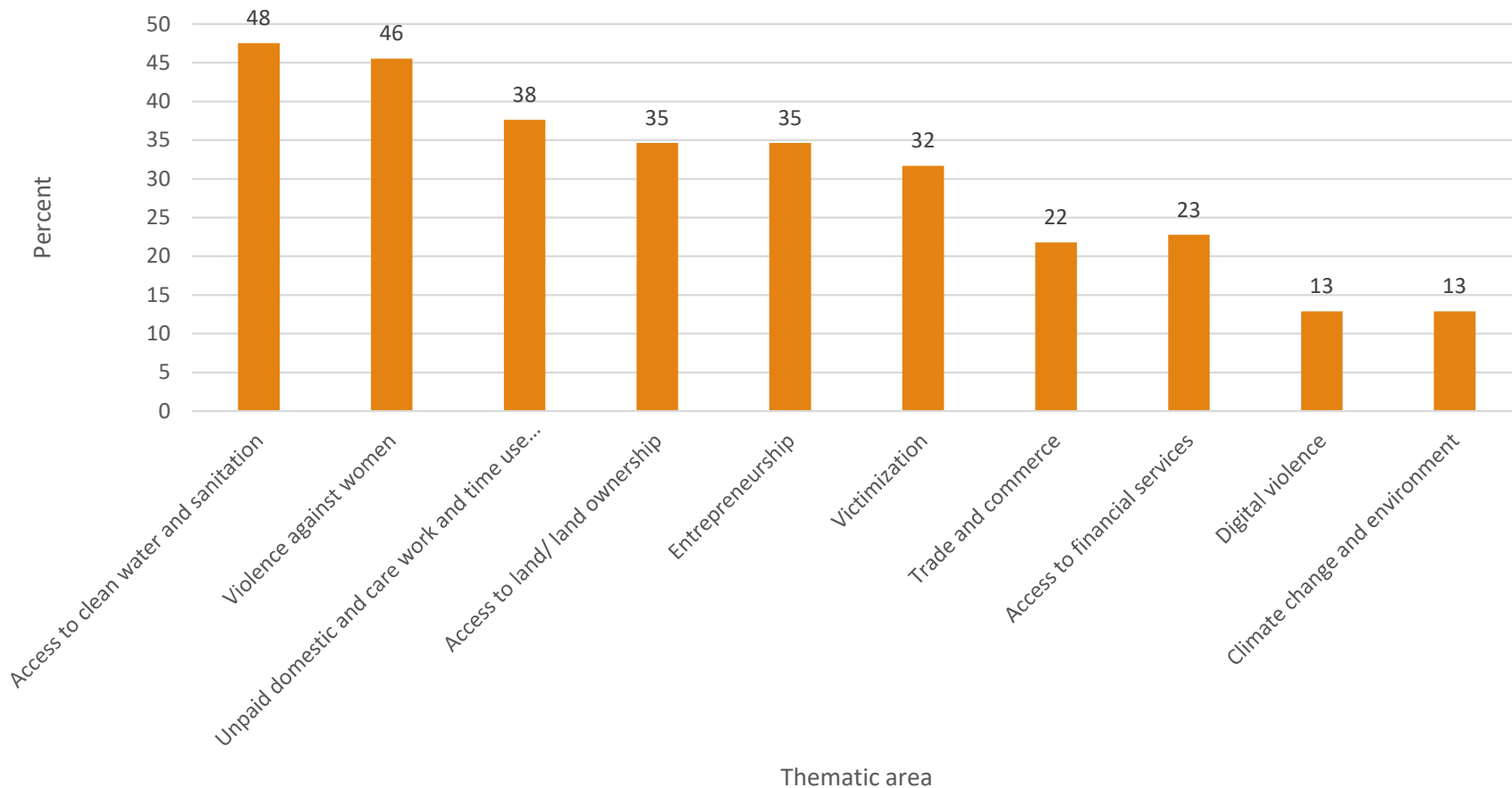
# Sources of data and their use for gender statistics (select topics)



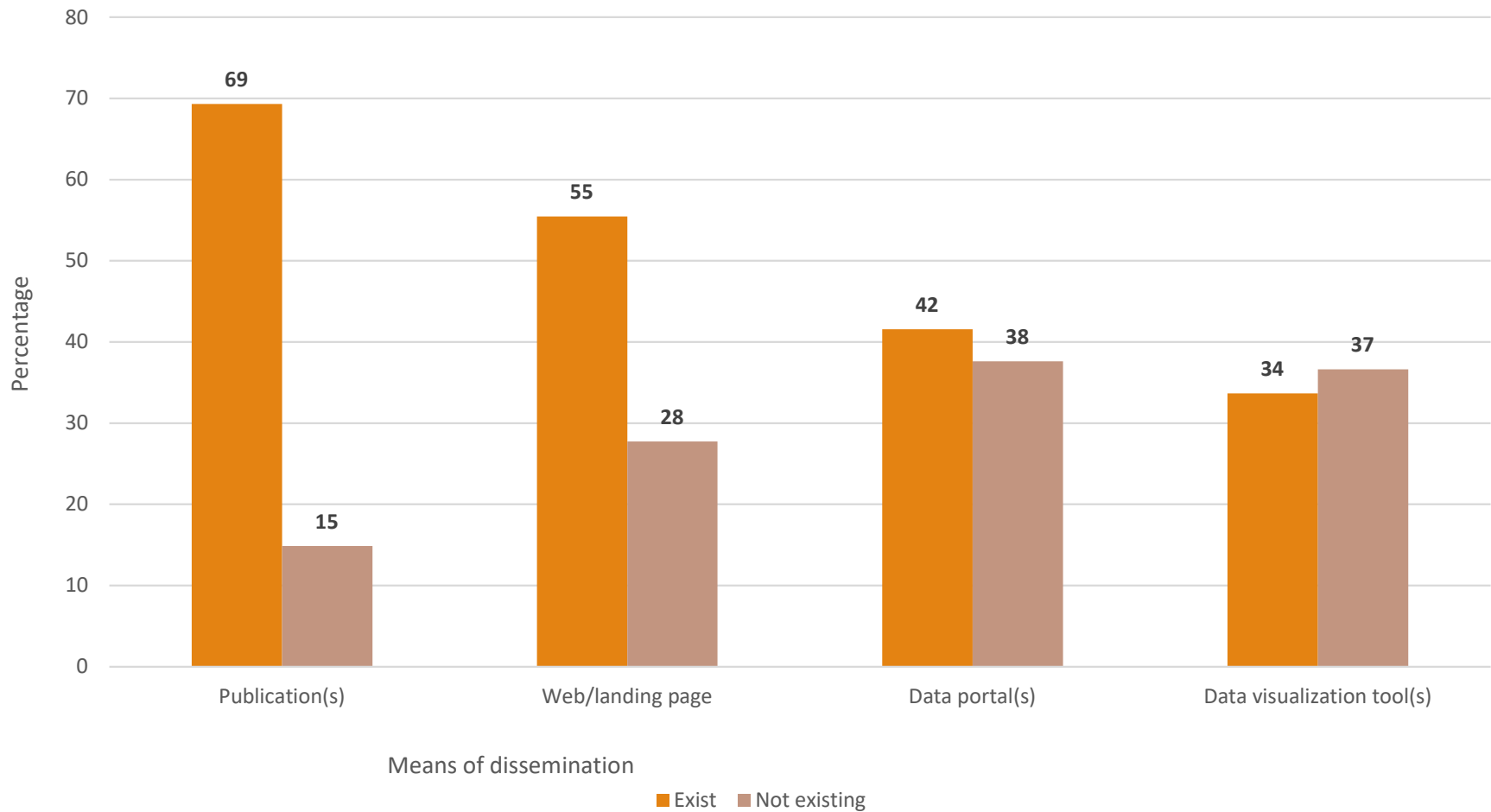
# Sources of data and their use for gender statistics (select topics)



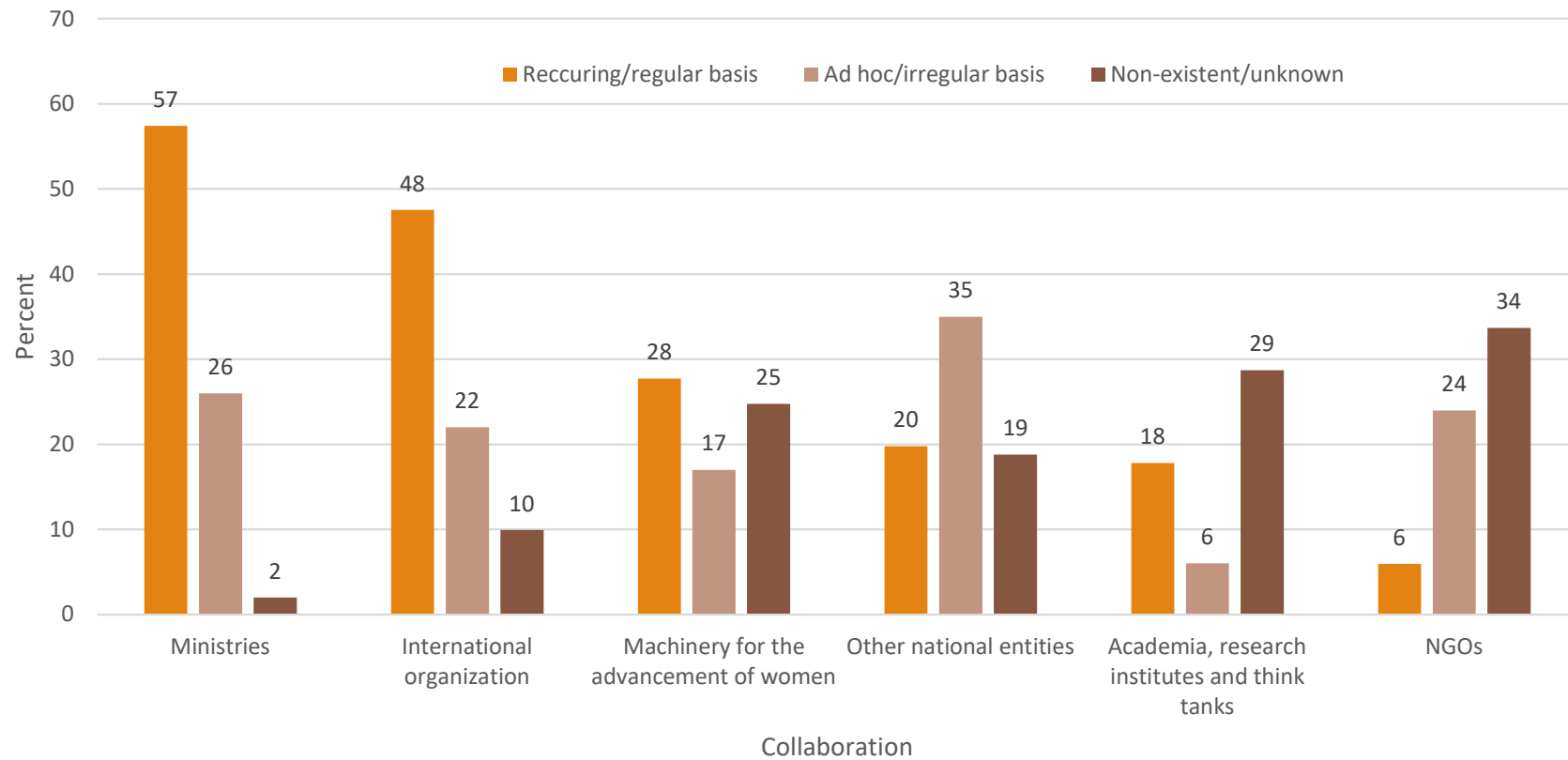
# Gender mainstreaming with data produced on recurring and periodic basis (select topics)

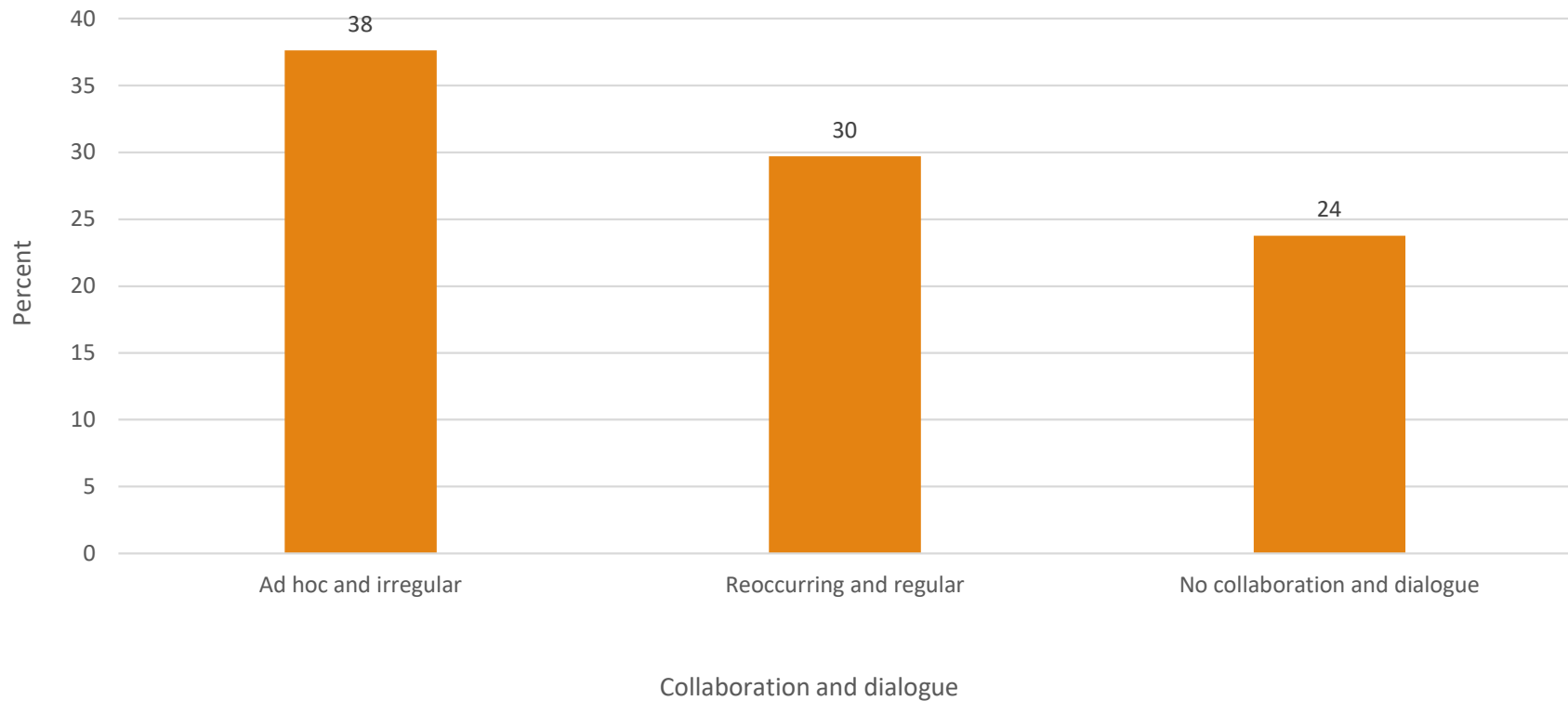


# Collaboration for production of gender statistics



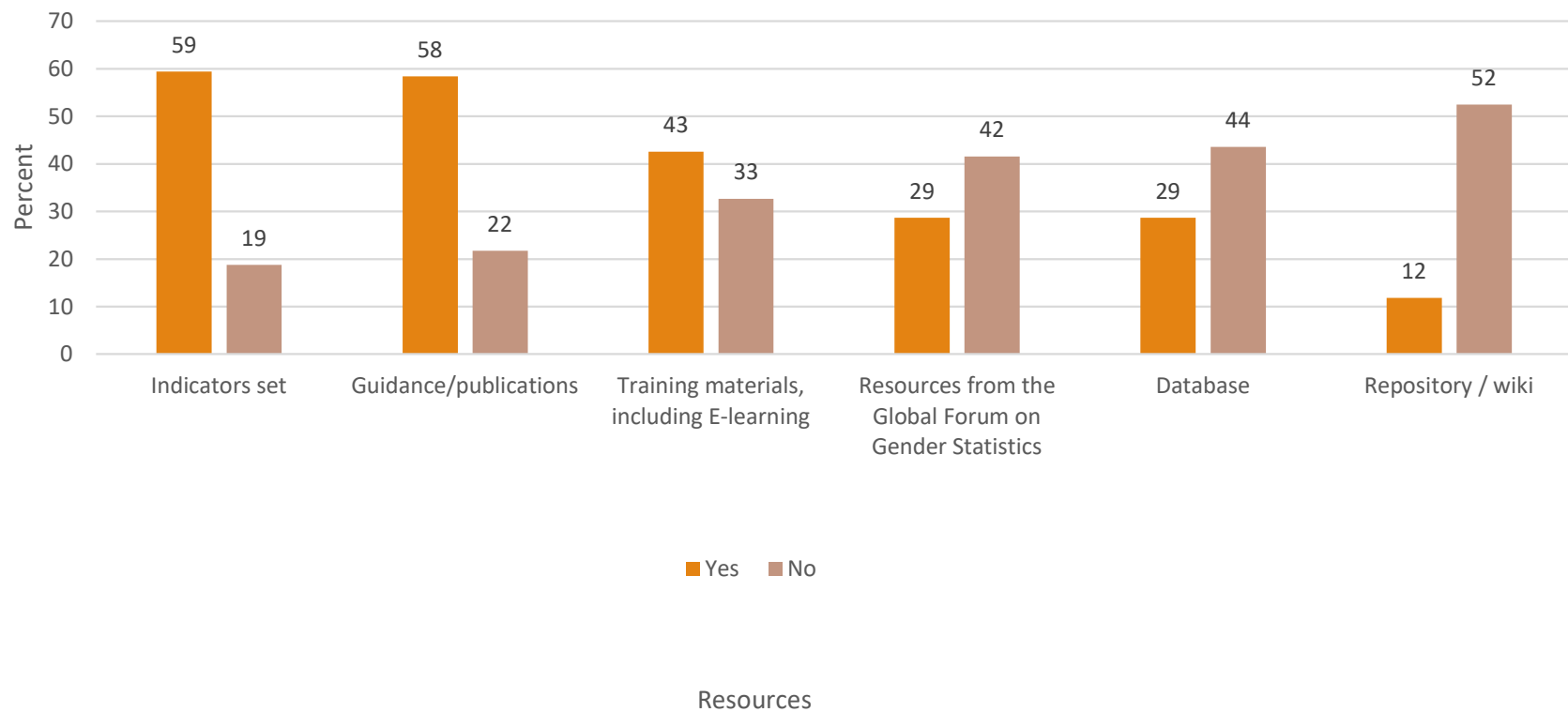
# Collaboration and dialogue between users and producers of gender statistics

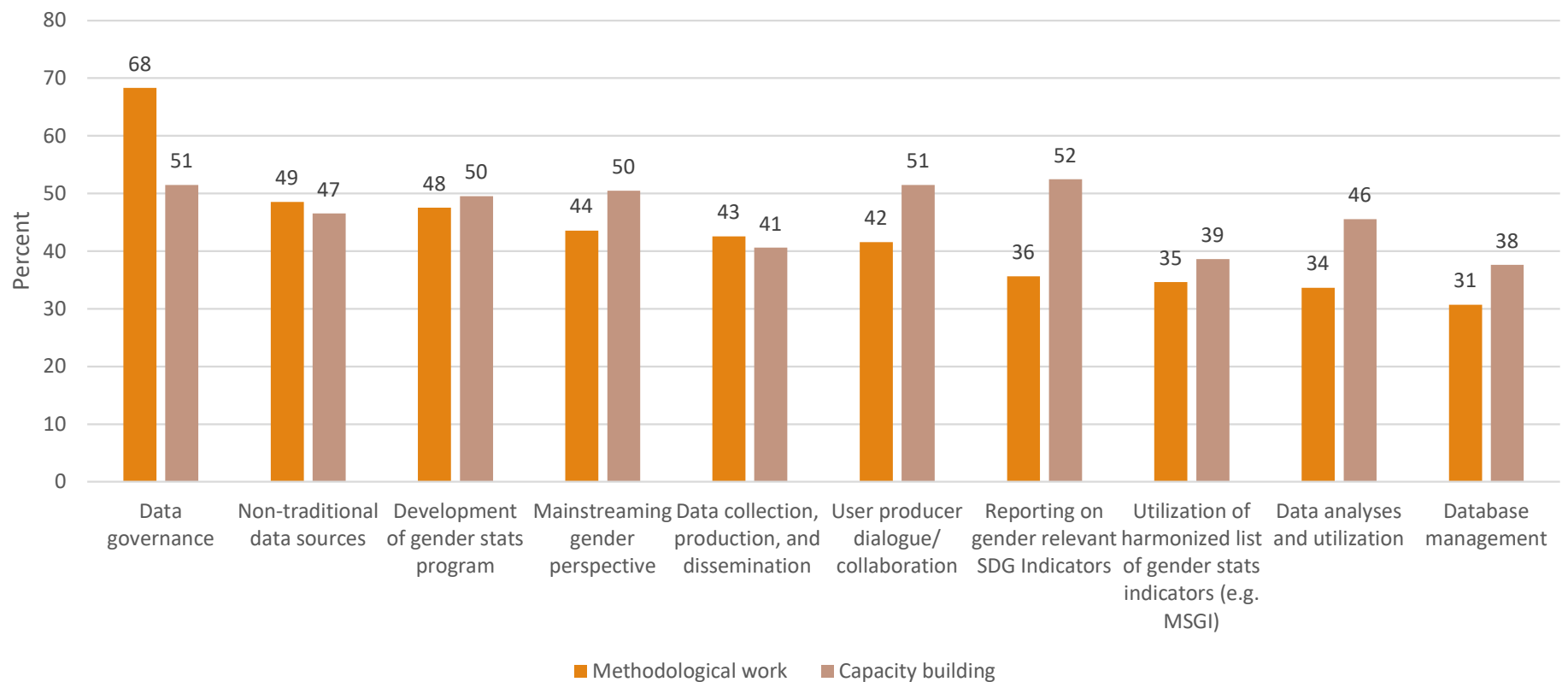
