IAEG-GS work on data disaggregation



- The IAEG-GS:
 - Reviewed SDG indicators under *Goal 5: Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls* in preparation of its 11th meeting in Rome, Italy, 30-31 Oct 2017
 - Agreed on disaggregation dimensions and their categories, relevant for gender analysis.
 - IAEG-GS revised the categories based on feedbacks received from IAEG-SDGs (2018)

Proposed dimensions and categories



Place of occurrence*

- 1. Private residential premises (including own home or yard; others' home or yard)
- 2. Open area, street or public transport (including street, alley, parking lot, parks, public transit, other open area)
- 3. Schools or other educational institutions
- 4. Institutional settings (including prisons, care institutions, other)
- 5. Other commercial or public non-residential premises (including commercial premises, office buildings, other)
- 6. Other locations
- 9. Not known

* Based on International classification of crimes for statistical purposes (ICCS) and UN Guidelines for Producing Statistics on Violence against Women—Statistical Surveys.
