


## National Quality Assurance Framework





### 1. Capacity Development

- **Virtual workshops**: 17 workshops on different topics such as classifications, statistical process, anonymization, amongst others, are currently offered.
- **Joint work with internal and external producers** in adopting and adapting international standards.
- **34 documents** related with guides, manuals and other guidelines published on the NSS website.

- Experimental statistics (Prioritizing the attention to information demands, recognizing the challenges in quality of working with new sources and methods)





#### 5. High-level commitment


- There is a statistical quality group at DANE with 20 people working with internal and external producers.

### II. Challenges of the start-up and in the sustaining of quality culture at DANE

- 1. Extending quality culture across the NSO, NSS and verifying whether the established guidelines are being applied.
- 2. Carrying out regular evaluations in regards to the QAF implementation, in both NSO and the other entities within the NSS. To carry out the diagnosis for 20 NSS entities out of a total of 105 during the validity of the National Statistical Plan 2023-2027.
- 3. Strengthening of the awareness-raising processes of the tools provided by NSO regarding quality assurance.
- 4. Promoting the documentation of statistical processes and their results in NSO and the NSS and their publication for effective use by all stakeholders.



## III. Expectations, advantages of working with the Subgroup on Quality Culture, and how other countries could benefit from this.

- 1. Learning from good practices and experiences of other countries in order to strengthen the processes developed by DANE.
- 2. Implementing the maturity model regarding quality culture.
