Improving the quality of SDG indicators in Uzbekistan

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In September 2015 Uzbekistan joined the international sustainable development agenda voiced at the UN Summit, and undertook a commitment on implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals until 2030 at the national level.

Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of 20 October 2019 No. 841 “On Measures to Implement National Goals and Targets in the Field of Sustainable Development for the Period until 2030”

National Sustainable Development Goals and Targets, which include 16 National Goals and 125 Targets, were approved *задач*

A list of national SDG indicators was approved, which included 206 indicators recognized as relevant for Uzbekistan

SDG website was developed jointly with UNDP

The website is located at nsdg.stat.uz and works in test mode. It currently contains information on 64 indicators of the National SDGs

4. Education



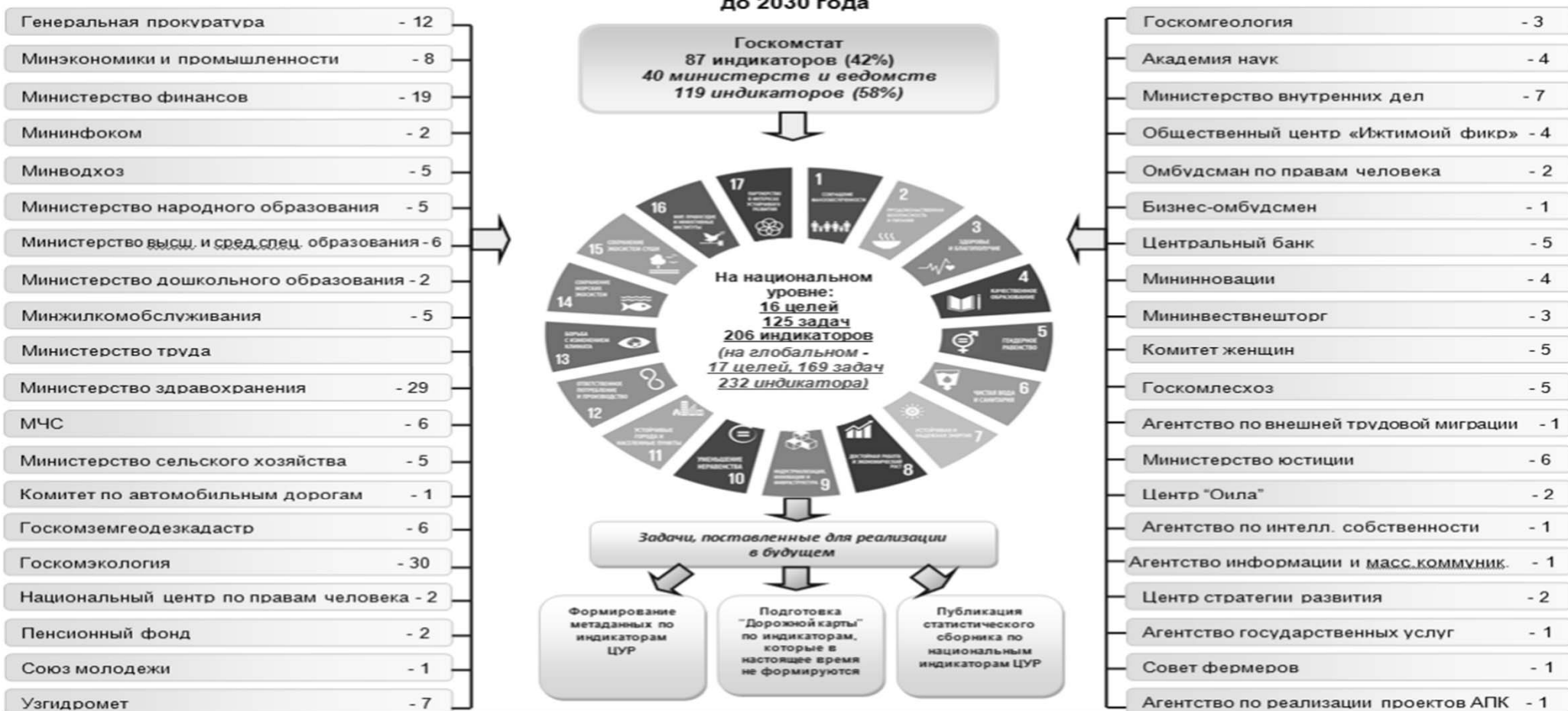

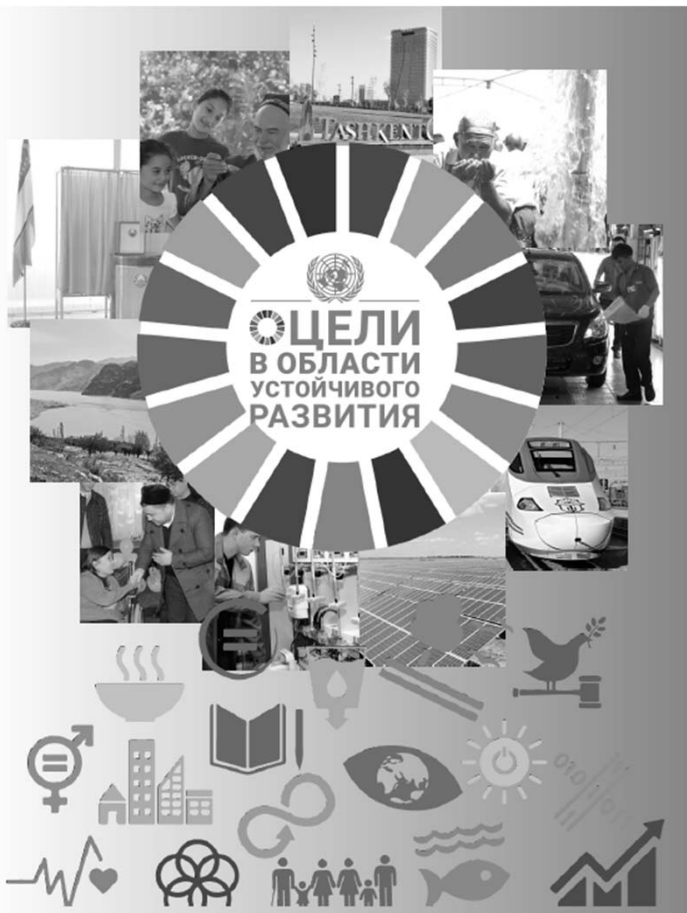

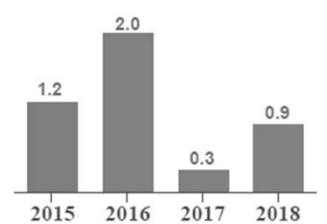

Challenges faced in organizing SDG monitoring

The calculation methodology of individual indicators proposed by the UN system differs from the national one, and therefore it should be adapted to national conditions.

Currently, most of the SDG indicators are formed by specialized ministries and departments that have difficulty in forming a methodology for the SDG indicators, which in turn slows down work in this area.

When forming individual indicators, ministries and departments have difficulties associated with financial resources.

For forming a methodology and developing SDG indicators, ministries and departments have a low level of scientific potential.

Proposals for strengthening statistical capacity



Holding thematic seminars with participation of experts



Strengthen collaboration with international organizations for technical assistance



Adapt the calculation methodology proposed by the UN system to national conditions
