

4. Education















June 2019 in Tashkent







Challenges faced in organizing SDG monitoring

The calculation methodology of individual indicators proposed by the UN system differs from the national one, and therefore it should be adapted to national conditions.

When forming individual indicators, ministries and departments have difficulties associated with financial resources.

Currently, most of the SDG indicators are formed by specialized ministries and departments that have difficulty in forming a methodology for the SDG indicators, which in turn slows down work in this area.

For forming a methodology and developing SDG indicators, ministries and departments have a low level of scientific potential.
