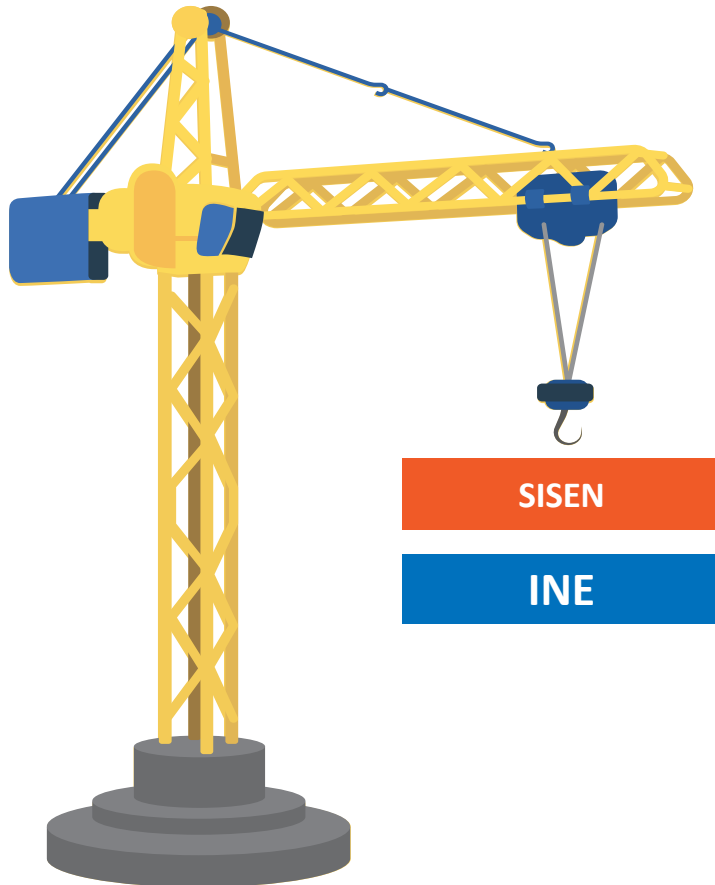

"Which establishes the modernization of the National Statistical System (SISEN) and creates the National Institute of Statistics (INE)."



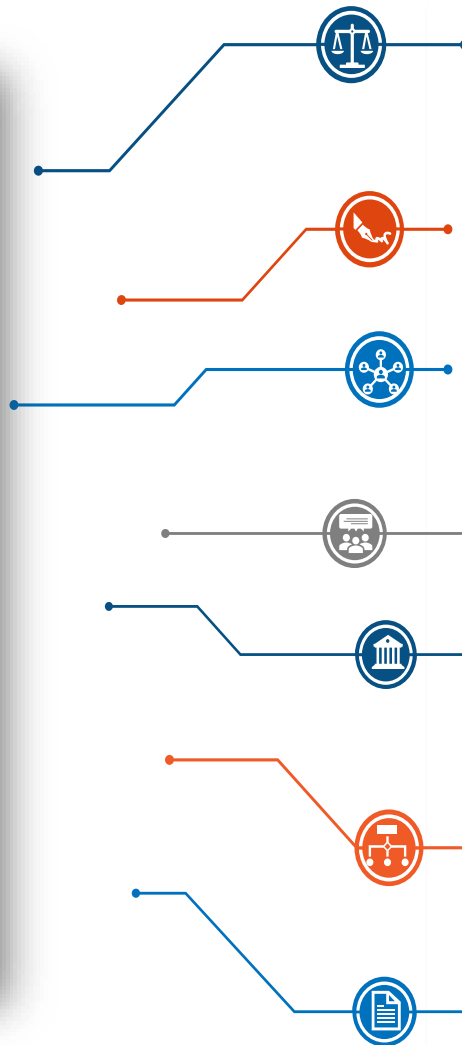
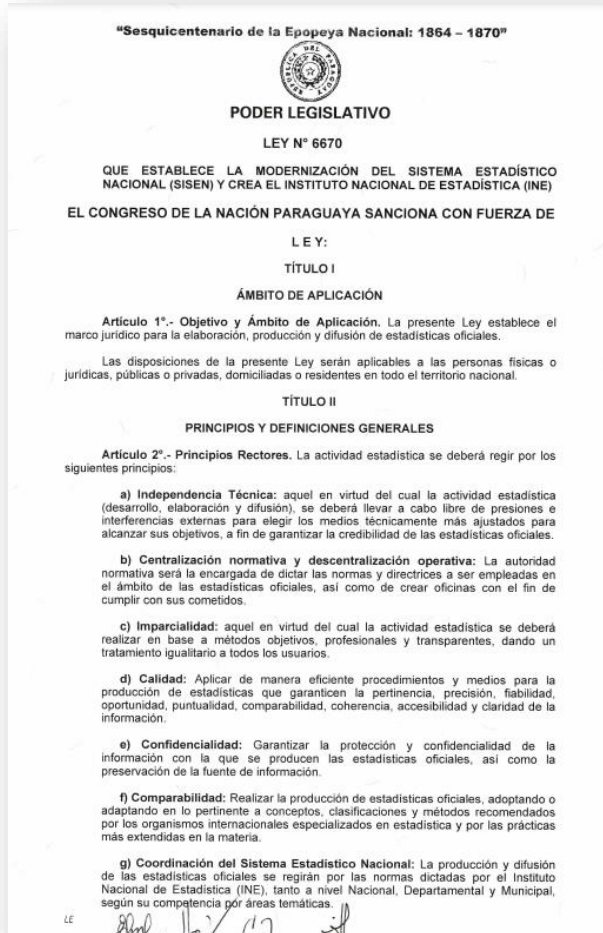
Generates the guidelines of...

- Technical,
- Methodological, and
- Technological order,

As well as the standards to be applied throughout the National Statistical System (SISEN) for **the generation of official statistical information**, with a view to...

- Its integration,
- harmonization,
- analysis,
- dissemination and
- the interoperability of the statistical information sub-systems.

And its adaptation to scientific-technological advances and to the changes generated in all areas of society, economics, environmental and other relevant areas, establishing coordination, control, evaluation and feedback mechanisms.



Art. 1. Establishes the legal framework for the elaboration, production and dissemination of official statistics.

Art. 2. Establishes “*Governing Principles*”.

Art. 4. Modernizes and integrates the “*National Statistical System*”. Establishes its competence and functions.

Art. 8. Creates the “*National Counseling of Statistics*”. Establishes its functions.

Art. 12. Creates the “*National Institute of statistics*” (INE) as the Governing Authority of the system and its functions.

Art. 22. Establishes structure, organization and resources.

Art. 31. Creates the “*National Statistical Plan*”.

Article 2°.- Governing Principles.

Statistical activity shall be governed by the following principles:

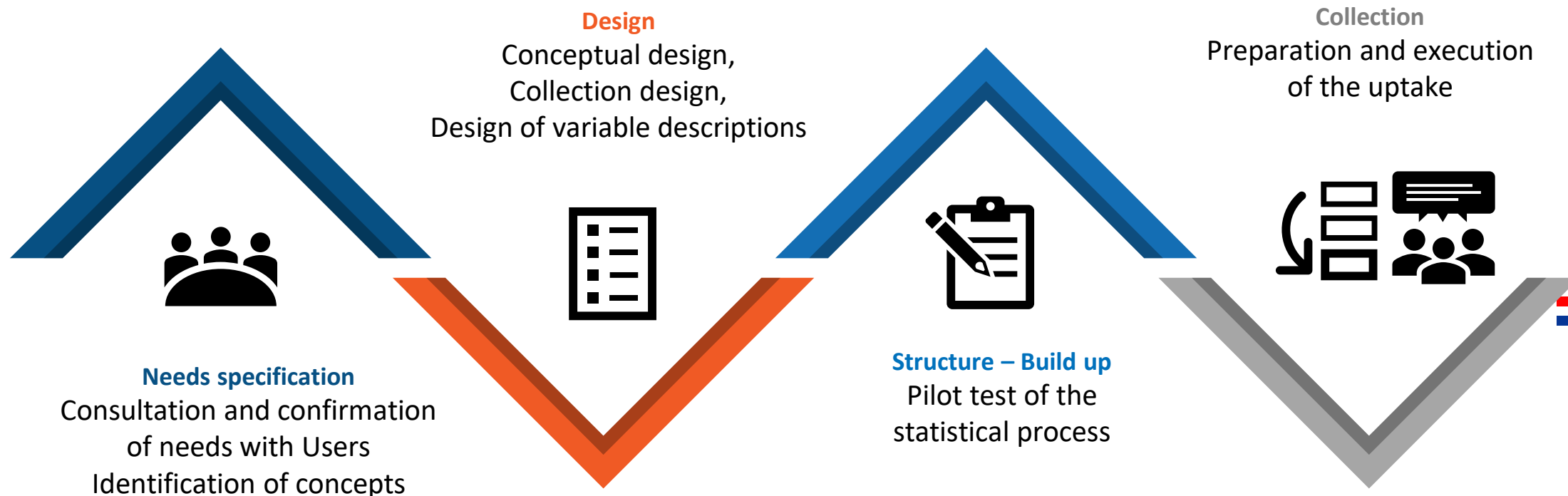
- a **Technical Independence**
No external pressure and interference to ensure the credibility of the statistics.
- b **Regulatory centralization and operational decentralization**
In charge of issuing standards in the field of official statistics.
- c **Impartiality**
Statistics based on objective, professional and transparent methods; equal treatment of all users.
- d **Quality**
To ensure the relevance, accuracy, reliability, timeliness, punctuality, comparability, coherence, accessibility and clarity of the information.
- e **Confidentiality**
Ensure the protection and confidentiality of information; preserve the source of information.
- f **Comparability**
Use of concepts, classifications and methods recommended by international organizations specialized in statistics and by the most widespread practices in the field.
- g **National Statistical System Coordination**
Governed by regulations issued by INE, at the national, departmental and municipal levels, according to its competence by subject area.

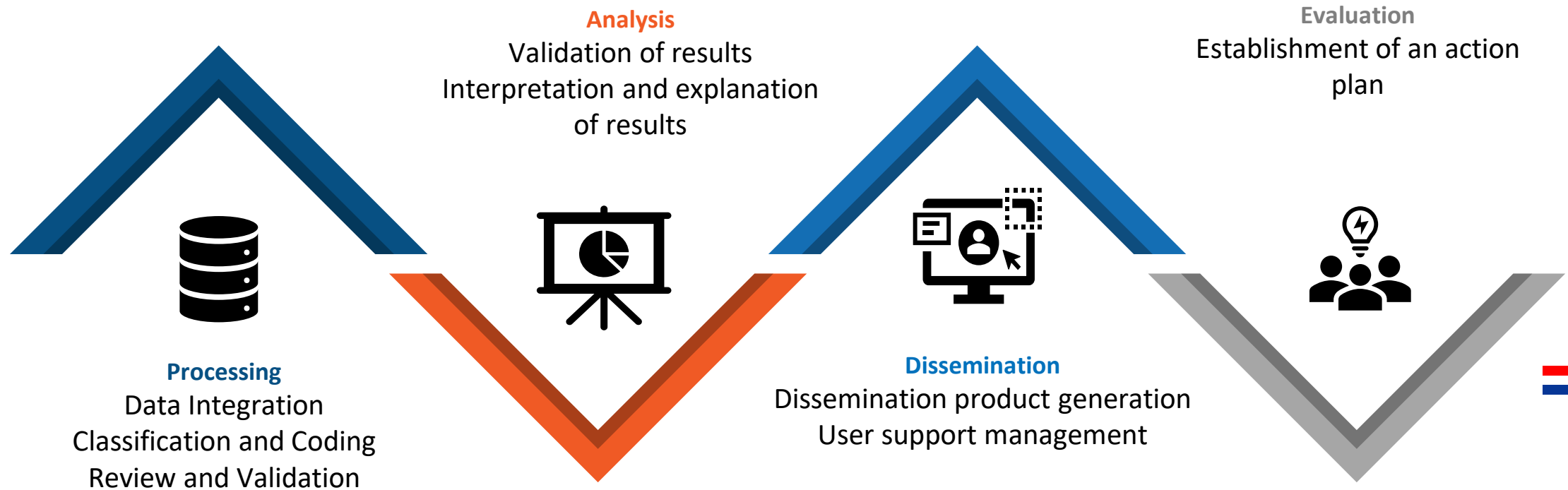

It is governed by the guiding principles established in Law 6670/2020, as well as international methodological recommendations for statistical production.





Technical assistance service for the development of methodological materials in the production process of statistical operations (censuses, surveys and administrative records).



1. Preparation of the methodological material ***"Technical Standards for the Official Statistical Production of Paraguay"***, following other reference models of the LA region, as well as incorporating information from other bibliographies of interest to INE-PY.
2. Elaboration of the methodological material ***"Standard Process for the Statistical Use of Administrative Records in Paraguay"***, according to the Generic Model of the GSBPM statistical process.
3. Revision and adjustment of the material ***"Code of Good Practices for Statistics in Paraguay"***, available in preliminary version.
4. Review and adjustment of the material ***"Guide for the documentation of Metadata and Microdata of SISEN Statistical Operations"***, available in preliminary version.

Gradual adoption of international good practices and recommendations in the production, development, and dissemination of official statistics.



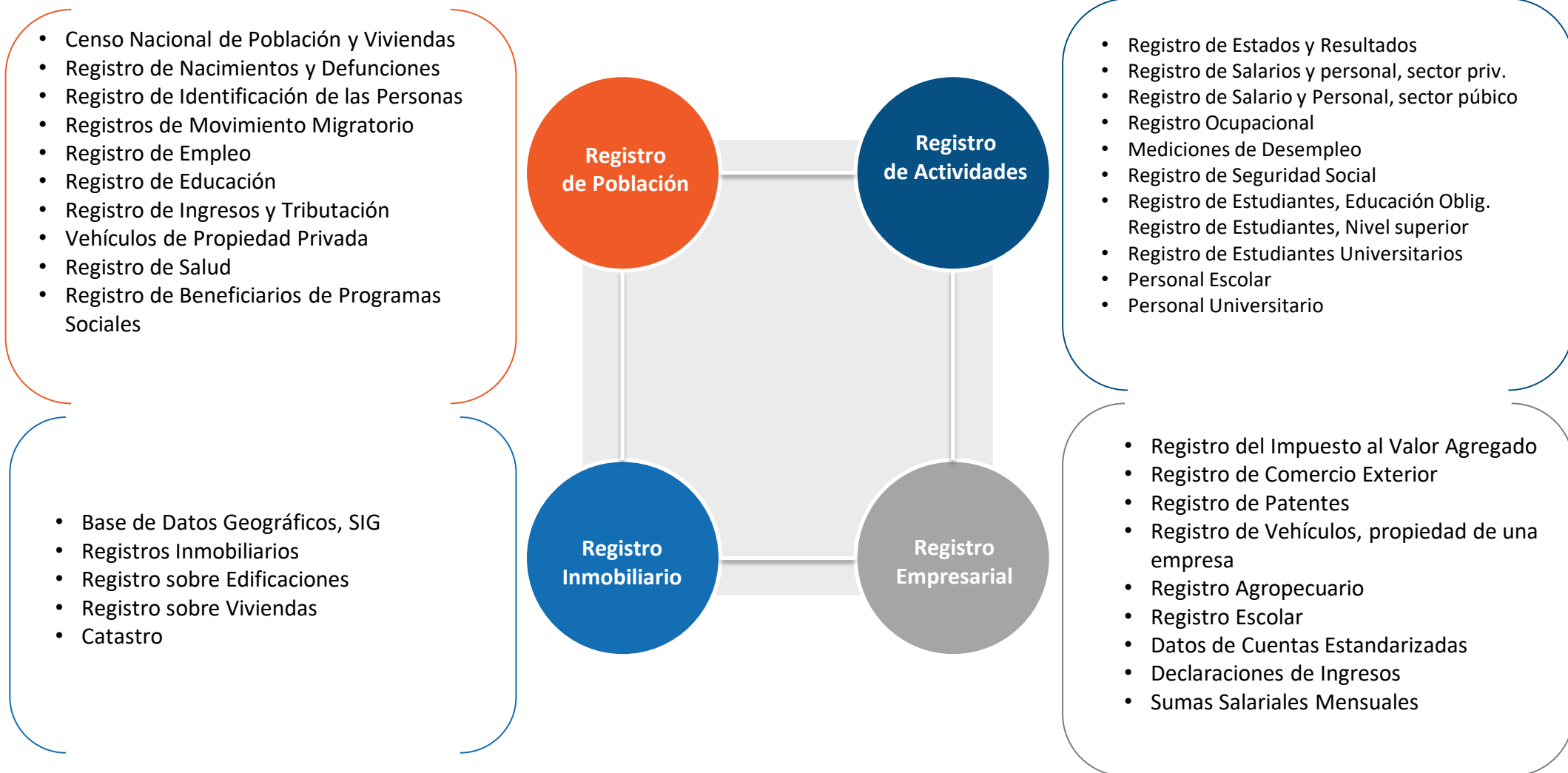
Promote the standardization of statistical operations produced by SISEN.

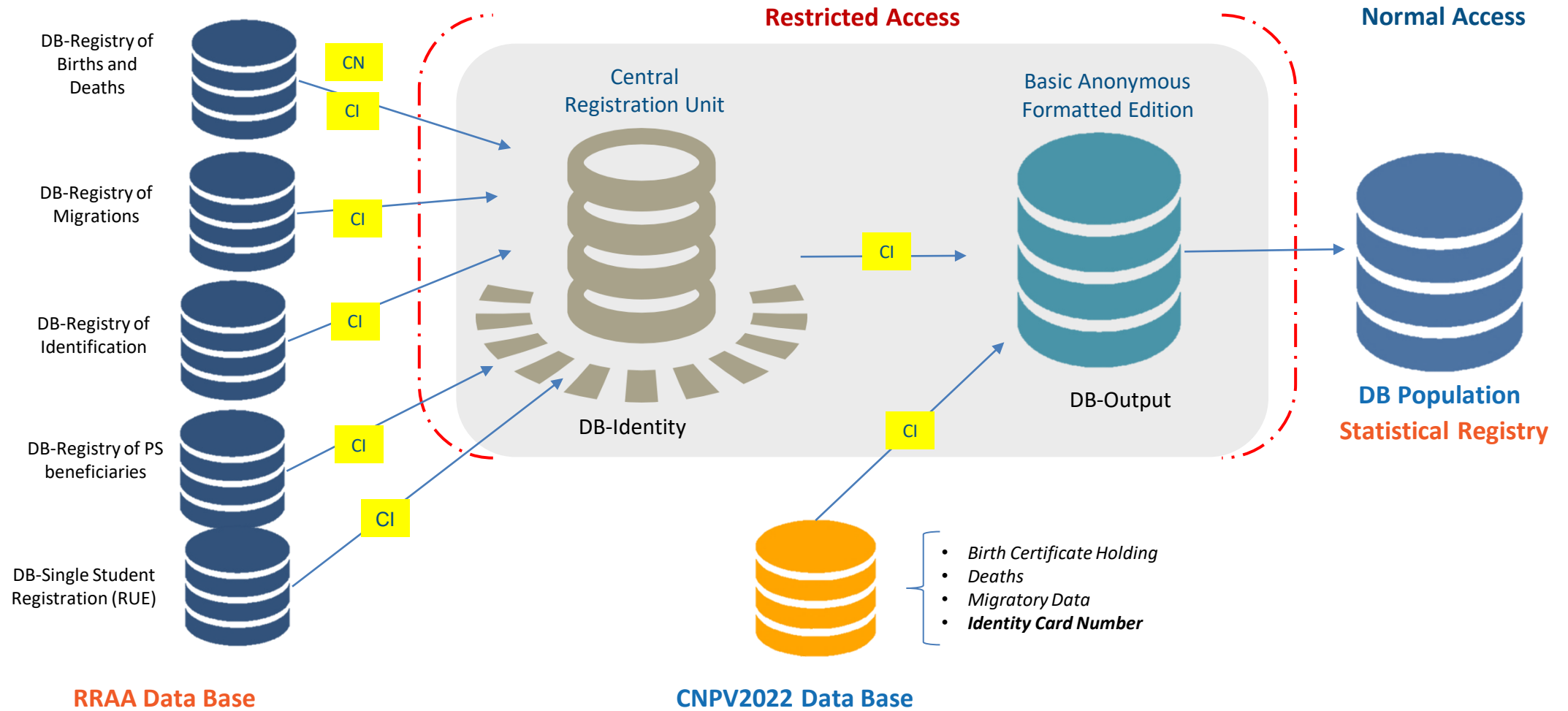


Application of the Continuous Survey of the Primary Quality Assessment of the RRAA for statistical purposes directed to the State Agencies and Entities (OEE).
