### Treatment of pension schemes in the new SNA

Thank you for your letter sent to the ECB on 14 November 2006, in which you request the ECB's view on the compromise proposal regarding the treatment of pension schemes in the reviewed system of National Accounts (SNA).

The ECB strongly supports this proposal, which was recently elaborated by the Eurostat/ECB Task Force on the treatment of pension schemes in the new SNA. The ECB also confirms that this Task Force will undertake further work on the issues mentioned in your letter, including the specification of the new table which shows the flows and (imputed) stocks of pension entitlements of all pension schemes. According to the current draft, this table will show the opening balance sheet, the various transactions and other flows that contribute to the changes of the pension entitlements, and the closing balance sheet. However, estimating entries for specific government-sponsored pension schemes and for pension-related social security schemes available in the various EU countries will require quite complex model calculations, whereby the outcomes may vary considerably depending on the assumptions that are made.

The ECB thinks that the solution found for the recording of pension schemes has the advantage that the core accounts will not be distorted by imputed, uncertain liabilities, while users will still obtain comprehensive and internationally comparable information on pension schemes.

More generally, the ECB remains committed to contribute to the successful completion of the SNA review project, also because of its key interest in regular national accounts statistics that are globally comparable in practice.
