Introduction

The Well-Being and Sustainability Task Team has drafted a range of guidance notes with recommendations for enhancing and broadening the SNA framework to better capture specific aspects of household economic well-being. This guidance note brings together these recommendations and explains how they will be reflected in the new SNA to provide users with coherent information on elements affecting current and future well-being.

As the recommendations in related guidance notes have already been endorsed, the main focus in this global consultation is on how they will be coherently presented to best support users in analyzing elements of current and future well-being, including possible trade-offs and win-wins. Furthermore, the consultation is seeking insights in possible prioritization of the recommendations, in view of their relevance and the feasibility to compile.
