CMTT Deliverables

Communication Framework



Terminology and Branding (GN)

Clarified / consistent terminology and (expanded) definitions to improve **users' understanding** of concepts, methods, and presentation of accounts.

Proposed branding of the statistical guidance and system.

Taxonomy (GN)

Improve users' understanding of economic statistics with:

- Clear and standardized taxonomy for vintages of data.
- Detailed revisions framework to explain changes to vintages.
- Taxonomy for tables / accounts and for labeling product quality.

Alignment Framework (GN)

An internationally consistent framework for statistical producers to communicate to their users, their alignment with statistical guidance concepts, methods, accounting rules and classifications.

CMTT Deliverables



Compilers Hub

A digital platform that will facilitate collaboration among producers and users of economic statistics as well as improve the awareness of new and existing information.

Digital Manuals

Digitally-enabled statistical manuals with interactive tools and cross references.

Today **AEG** Three revised 'draft' Guidance Notes and way forward

Overall, attendees have welcomed the initiatives, direction of travel and supported the evolving proposals to improve the various strands of communication with a focus on comparability and users.

However, some caution:

- Terminology: Need to avoid over-simplifying technical terms.
- **Taxonomy**: Applicability of some proposals when considered against existing traditional country practices and how flexibly these proposals could be applied.
- Alignment Framework: An 'explicit score' to measure alignment is not favoured but a scoring system would be a useful tool for internal planning, prioritisation and statistical development.

Immediate next steps

Today is a key milestone, the CMTT are presenting three 'Draft' Guidance Notes:

- Each presentation has specific questions upon which we are seeking feedback from the AEG.
- Changes, proposals and confirmation of direction of travel being sought from the AEG.

Over the summer 2021, the CMTT will:

- Complete the various remaining issues (e.g. role and emphasis of net and gross variables)
- Incorporate the feedback from the CMTT and AEG.

It is expected that all three Guidance Notes will be tested but the testing will take a different form for each.

Alignment Workstream – Next Steps

Objective: Create clear measures to communicate the degree of alignment with the international standards.

Guidance Note in 'draft' form for AEG.

This includes a proposed alignment framework for SNA, BPM and GFSM.

The next stage will include addressing feedback from CMTT and AEG consultations and obtain approval for global consultation.

Terminology and Branding Workstream – Next Steps

Objective: Review current macroeconomic accounting terminology and propose **simpler** alternative terms and **clarified definitions/descriptions** for more consistent and accurate use in the communication with users **to better convey the meaning and interpretation of the concepts and methods**.

The goal is not to change the concepts or definitions used but to express them in a non-technical easier to understand way.

Guidance Note in 'draft' form for AEG.

Work is on-going to develop a harmonized user-friendly glossary consistent across domains and aligned with existing accounting standards. The next stage will also include addressing feedback from CMTT and AEG consultations and obtain approval for global consultation.

Objective: Develop a taxonomy to communicate macroeconomic accounts releases, products, and product updates.

Participatory design sessions

Engaged internal stakeholders and partners from other IOs and NSOs to translate their vision into features and requirements that work together in a unified hub.

- 5 virtual whiteboarding sessions held in Mural
- 60-90 minutes each

Information architecture testing

Conducted with users to gather feedback on content priority and investigate mental models for categorization.

- 500 participants engaged
- 120+ completed responses

3 <=

Series of global interviews

Held with end users to investigate actual needs and behaviors — both validating and correcting previous assumption-based personas.

- 14 Interviews
- 45 Minutes Each
- 13 Countries
- 4 Statistical Domains

Low-fidelity wireframes

Mock-ups created considering the user research and stakeholder needs.

Designs are based on 'blue sky thinking' – they are conceptual.

Not all features will make it to the production

IT feasibility assessment

IMF will assess which features are feasible (at least at launch).

This will determine the design of the high-fidelity wireframes
