ISWGNA Meeting

Wednesday, 7 November 2018

Minutes

1. Research agenda task force

Replies from TF members to the questionnaire on the SNA research agenda were arriving after the deadline. From a first screening, some replies indicate priorities as requested, while others rather ask about the process for the SNA revision. A summary of progress will be provided the upcoming ISWGNA management group on 15 November and a full analysis presented at the AEG meeting on 27-29 November 2018.

2. Update on the capacity building task force

At the last TF meeting, the discussion mainly focused on sharing existing information and the need to develop a suitable website for this purpose. The ISWGNA report to the 2019 UNSC report will highlight the new developments and stepped up efforts, including the work done to avoid duplication of work streams, and to mention that countries also have a responsibility to minimise duplication of assistance to them.

3. 27-29 November AEG meeting: review of draft agenda

Invitations for the meeting have been sent out. The ISWGNA reviewed the agenda and the preparation status of the different contributions. This resulted in a limited number of item rearrangements. 4. AEG membership

Mrs Sri Soelistyowati of the national statistical office of Indonesia accepted the invitation to become a member of the AEG.

5. Preparation of the ISWGNA report to the 2019 UNSC

The ISWGNA agreed on keeping the main report short and focused on elements requiring an endorsement by the UN Statistical Commission. The supplementary report including more detail on work programmes and manuals will also be prepared.
