Scope of National Account Statistics

- The scope of national accounts statistics is based on indicators set by the UNSC.
- The UNSC defined a standard minimum requirement data set (MRDS) to be the table required for meaningful policy decision making.
- The UNSC defined statistical implementation milestones.

Conclusions

- Many of the SADC countries have very well developed systems of national accounts.
- A little less than half of SADC countries are currently not providing national accounts data that meets milestone 2 as defined by the UNSC.
