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Arab region-Specific Spectrum

Characteristics

1. Different **development** stages (maturity)
2. Different **modernization** stage (ICT-Governance)
3. Different **priorities** (nationally/regionally)
4. Different **challenges** (financial, capacity, etc.)
5. Different **pressures** (humanitarian/development)

Demands

1. **Cost effectiveness** demand: registered based censuses and alternative sources
2. **Modernization** demand: ICT utilization, Access, transparency, responsive, sub-national, alignment with governance structure, NSS harmonized
3. **Humanitarian-specific** demand
4. **Governance-specific** demand: other produces, partnership with private sectors (Big data), Civil society (HR based data, tight data)

Arab region-Specific challenges

1. Humanitarian setting data needs: new data
2. Irrelevant traditional methods : timelines, sampling frames, etc.
3. Politicization of official statistics
4. Governance issues: alignment with government governance structure
5. Outdated infrastructure
6. Competing new data sources
7. Brain-drain and human capital issues
8. Lack of utilization of existing strength regionally

Registered based census	Bahrain, Qatar, Kuwait
Politicization of NSS	Somalia, Iraq, Sudan, Lebanon
Outdated methods of official statistics	Iraq, Syria, Libya, Yemen
Brain drain of human capital	Jordan, Palestine, Egypt
Lack of modernized infrastructure	Egypt, Syria, Oman, Syria, Libya, Yemen, S.A, etc
Lack of alignment with government structure	Iraq, Libya, Yemen
New governance structure	S.A, UAE
Access to data, transparency, etc.	Almost all countries

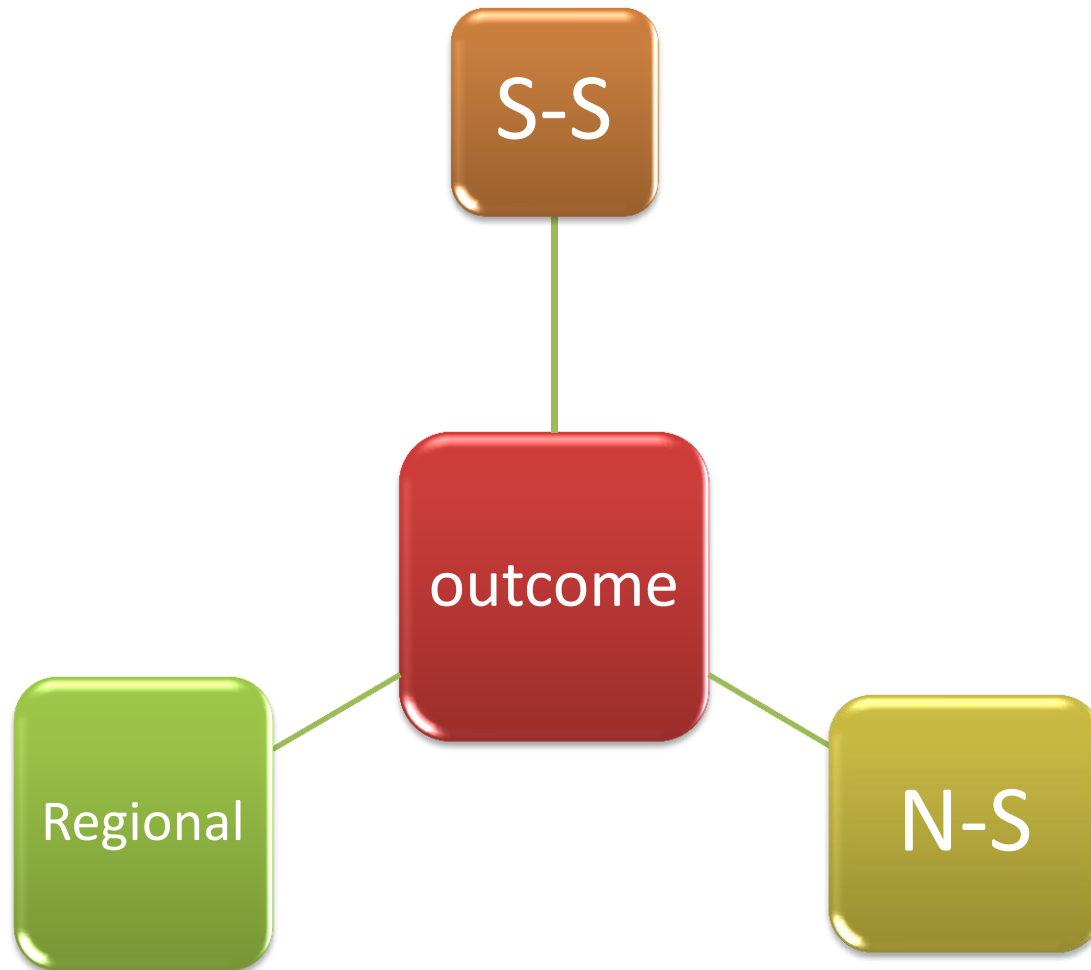
