- the European Statistics Code of Practice
- the Declaration on Professional Ethics of the International Statistical Institute



Key aspects for measuring and communicating the value of statistics

- Professional independence
- Confidence
- Data protection
- International standards
- User orientation
- Strong legal framework



Modernisation in support of the value in rapidly changing environments

- To increase the value of statistics in decision making in the modern information environment (availability of a wide range of information resources), it is especially important to standardise all processes of its production and dissemination.
- With this in view, we should primarily focus on the forming and adapting of perception processes in communication with users.



Continued

- The main development areas should include:
- metadata systems and quality assurance frameworks
- new data sources, including Big Data
- new data and metadata dissemination tools, including social media
- > data transparency, accessibility, design and simplicity



Continued

- services differentiated for user focus groups
- partnership and continued dialogue with administrative registers on the significance and efficiency of administrative data in the production of official statistics
- wider use of digital and other advanced technology



Continued

- development of institutional infrastructure of the system of official statistics
- strengthening the international statistical cooperation for the purposes of implementing international standards and tools and personnel training.



Conclusions

 Actions in the above development areas will also enable the transformation and modernisation of official statistical systems as regards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
