# Brief History

- NSO was conducted census on establishments in 1998.
- Based on which results the legal units was developed.
- Two new questionnaires were implemented for updating of business register, which are BR-1 for the new entities, and BR-2 for changing. (from July 1, 1999)
- Was conducted sample surveys based on legal units. (ISIC - C,D,E,F,G, H,O)

# Brief History

- Attention has been paid to the improvement of the quality of the register, the development of maintenance procedure and checking quality of the registered information.
- Business register is updating on a quarterly basis at the NSO.
- NSO has implemented new 3 questionnaires for updating.(from 2002)
- BR database was developed in MS MSQL Server environment. (Legal unit, Enterprise, Local unit)
- NSO was conducted census on establishments in 2004(covered some regions).

# Definitions of the units<sup>1</sup>

## ➤ “Legal units”

**legal or natural person; the legal unit is responsible for the enterprise; it always forms the legal basis for the statistical unit known as the enterprise.**

## ➤ “Enterprises”

**smallest combination of legal units which keeps a complete set of accounts; it is attached to one or more legal units.**

## ➤ “Local units”

**The local unit is an enterprise or part thereof (e.g. a workshop, factory, warehouse, office, mine or depot) situated in a geographically identified place.**

# Importance of BR

- fundamental for the compilation of statistics.
- a sampling base for surveys
- a source of information for statistical analysis of the population of enterprises and its demography
- Business register focuses on national needs.

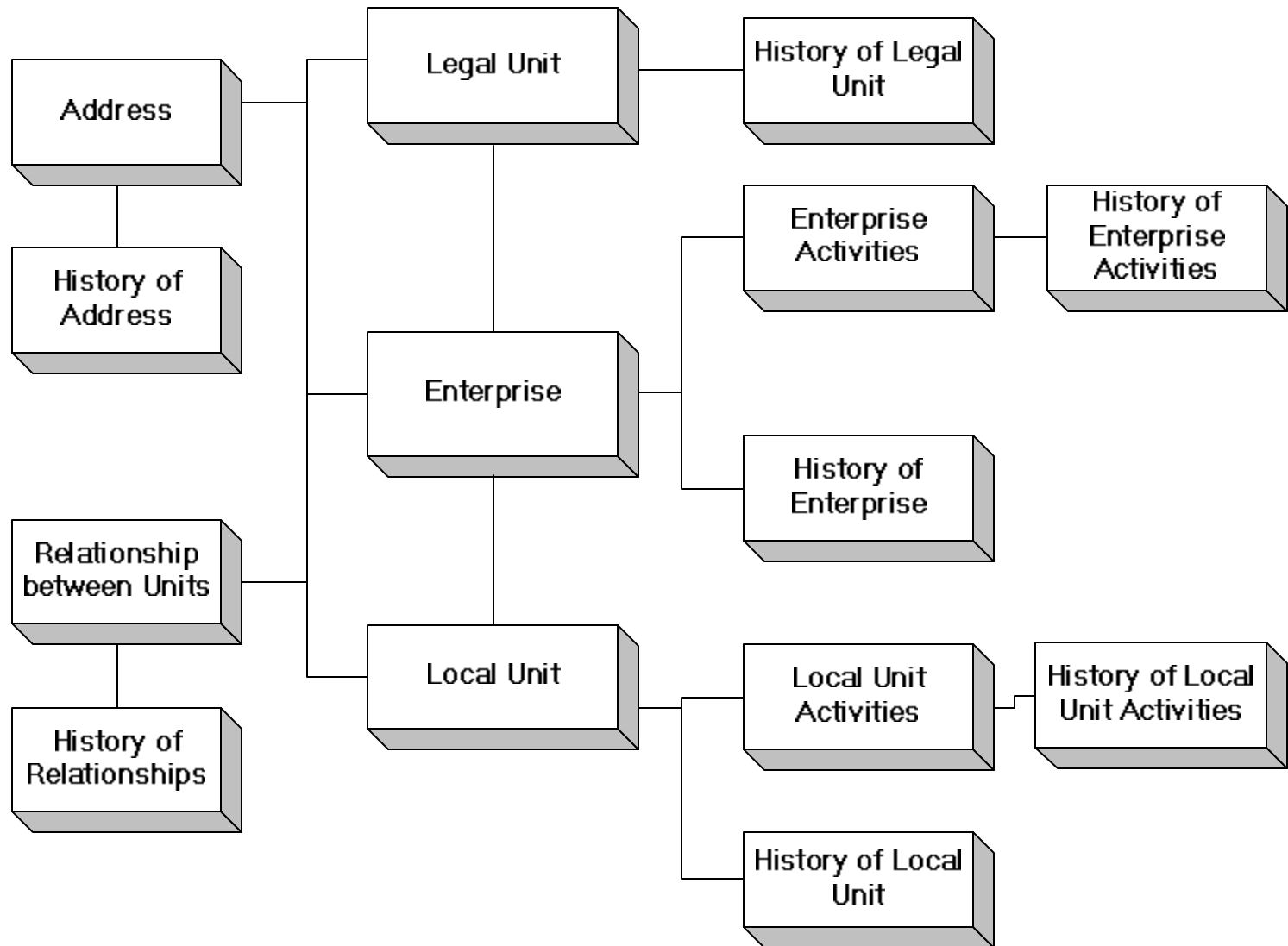

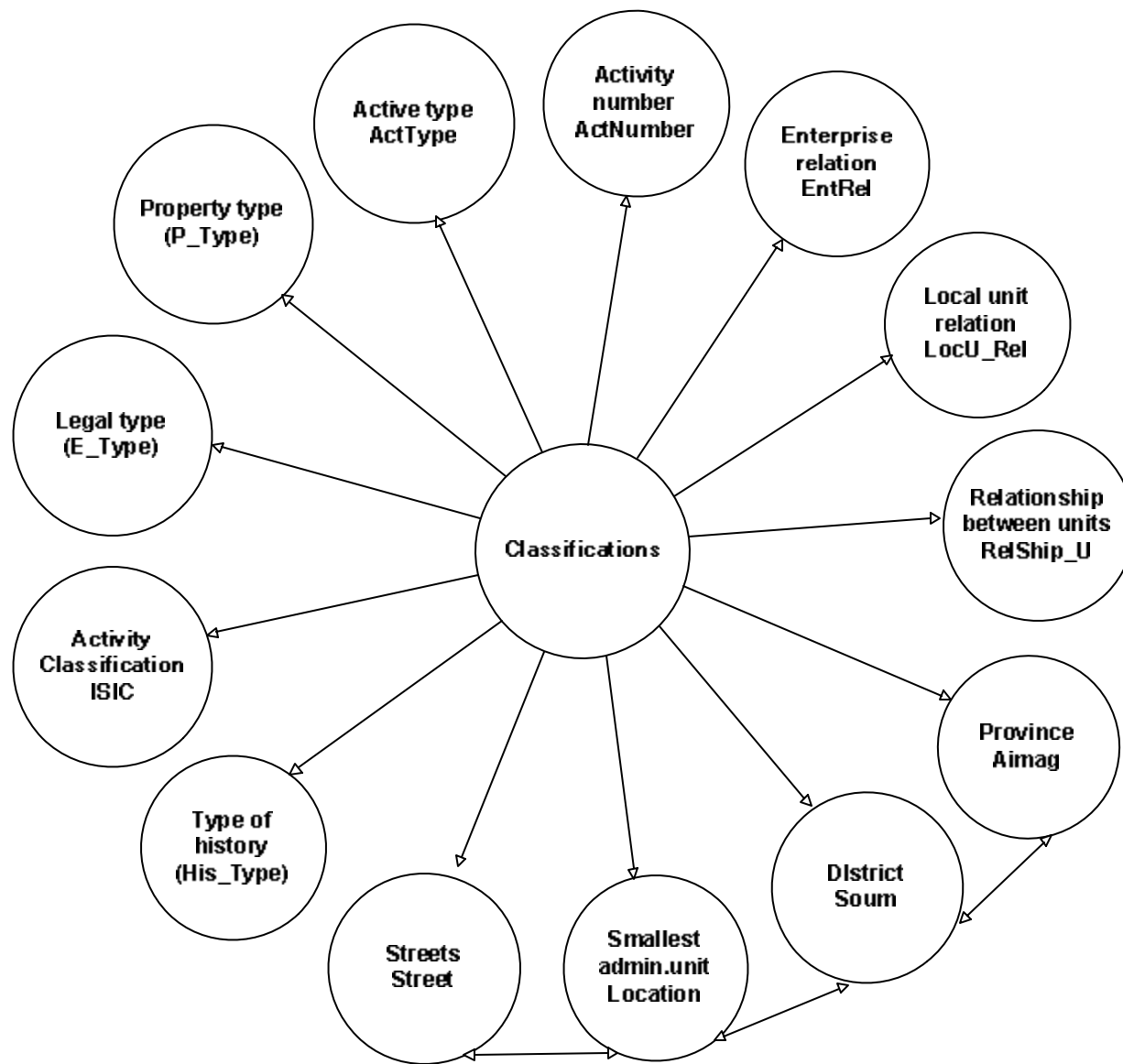

# Business Register, **coverage**

register covers all organisational units producing goods or services.

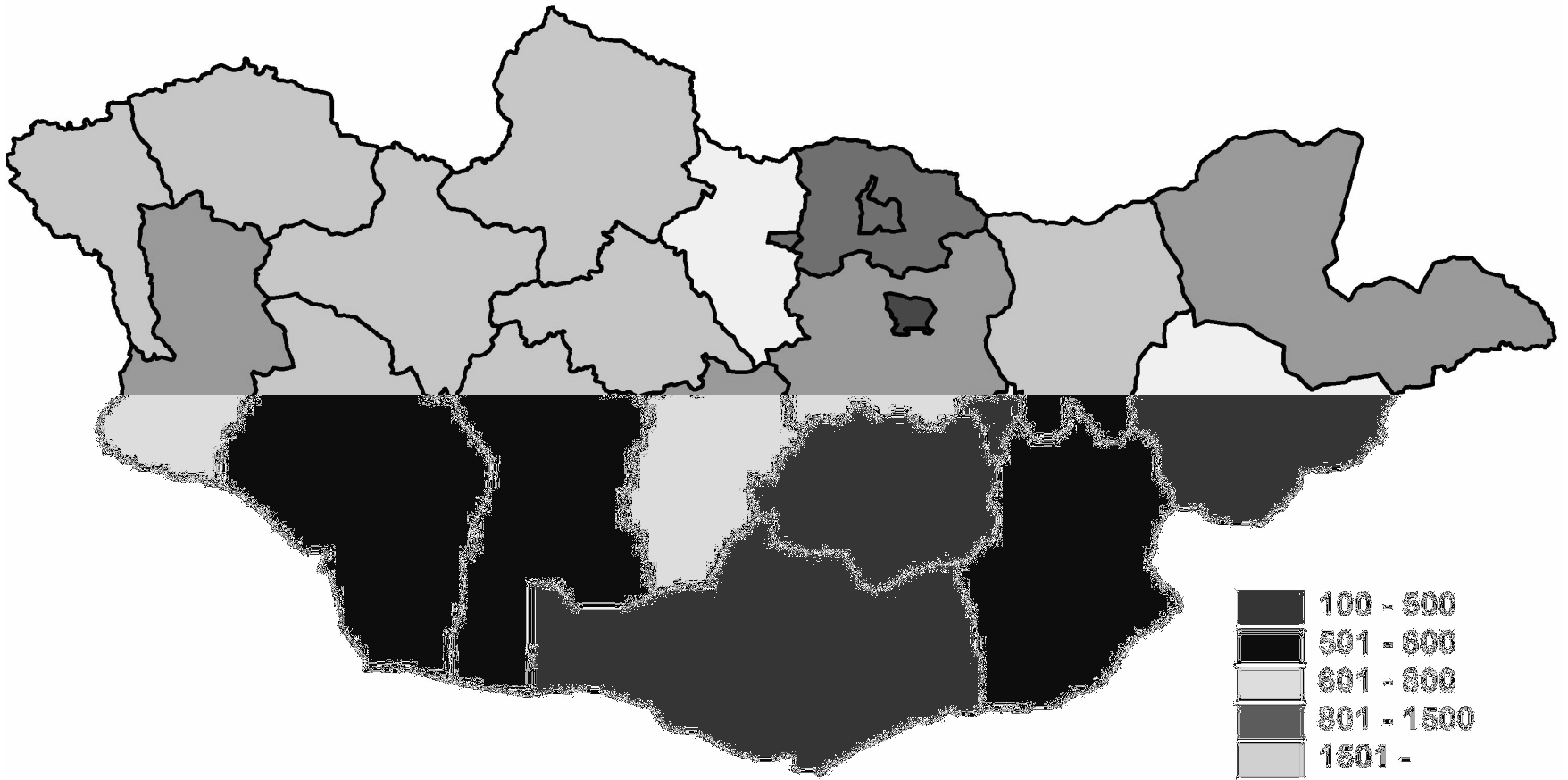
at the end of 2004 the BR covered over 34 thousand legal units.

# Business Register, coverage

Excluded:

- embassies and foreign government representations whose activity falls within Q of ISIC
- natural persons renting own property
- households producing goods or services for their own use
