- Revamped in 2005 – transformations to enhance data dissemination and enable users to locate and obtain statistics more conveniently and effectively

Statistics by Subject

Official statistics comprise statistics compiled by the Census and Statistics Department (CSO) and those compiled by various policy bureaux and other government departments. Broadly speaking, statistics which are of a general purpose and useful to various functional areas are mainly compiled by the CSO while those relating to more specific functional areas are compiled by the bureaux/departments concerned, in which case hyperlinks are provided to relevant websites for facilitating retrieval of these official statistics.

Population and Vital Events

Official statistics on "Population and Vital Events" presented in this section are primarily compiled by the Census and Statistics Department. This section provides statistics in this area together with related publications, press releases and other reference materials released by the Census and Statistics Department as well as hyperlinks to related official statistics on relevant websites for facilitating retrieval.

## “Chargeable” → “Free” Downloadable Statistical Publications

- Implemented on 7 June 2006
- Downloads increased from 200 a month prior to June 2006, to 200 a day in June 2006 and to 850 a day in July 2007
- Won the Hong Kong ICT Awards 2006: eGovt “Most Environmental Conscious” Bronze Medal
- Won the “Innovation Team Award of the 2007 Civil Service Outstanding Service Award Scheme” Merit Award




## Some Usage Statistics

- Publications downloaded: over 1 000 a day during weekdays; 400 during weekends & public holidays
- Trees saved (free download policy): 5 a day
- Tables customized: 16 000 monthly
- E-mails notifications sent : 30 000 monthly
- Page views from outside HK: 22%
