In reference to the draft chapter 19 of Volume 2 of the updated 1993 SNA we have two remarks:

- 1) page 8 point 19.32 – in the third sentence there is a lack of one word (at present we read “It is important that these employees be recorded in the employment measures....”, but we propose “It is important that these employees **should** be recorded in the employment measures....”);
- 2) page 10 point 19.46 – the second sentence is not consistent with the present situation, because *the ILO Resolution concerning the measurement of working time* has not been adopted yet by *the 18th International Conference of Labour Statisticians*, which is planned to be held between 24 November and 05 December 2008. Still now *the Resolution concerning statistics of hours of work, adopted by the 10th ICLS*, is in law. In fact definitions of hours worked used in the draft 19 chapter come from the draft ILO Resolution concerning the measurement of working time , which will be presented on the 18th ICLS for adoption, so we propose to leave the sentence, but after adding a note “**it will probably take place within days 24 November and 05 December 2008**” - till the moment of the draft Resolution adoption.
