General comment	The structure of Part A should be revised as para 25.2 to 25.8 give an overview over the whole chapter; there is a break between 25.8 and the subtitle 1 (and accordingly 25.9) that should be avoided.
25.1	Generally it is difficult to understand para 25.1 without having previously defined the concepts (formal/informal economy and employment). Consider beginning with the second sentence of 25.2. Beyond this the items b and d of 25.1 seem to need a further rewording in order to get their message obvious.
25.11	Consider deleting " <i>Increasingly it has been realised that</i> " at the begin of the 1 st sentence.

B. Characteristics of units in the informal economy (paragraphs 25.14-25.23)

25.16	The last but one sentence needs clarification: should " <i>excluded from the household sector</i> " be replaced by "included in <i>the household sector</i> "?
25.23	Generally this paragraph does not refer to any purpose of the suggested delimitation of the informal activity. This is confusing especially for the items(b) and (c) as the suggested exclusions "for pragmatic reasons" actually are included in the production boundary of the SNA. Please reconsider the argumentation of this paragraph and consider deleting (b) and (c).

C. The non-observed economy (paragraphs 25.24-25.30)

General comment	We welcome this part as a useful contribution to clarify the issue on exhaustiveness of National Accounts. Nevertheless it is confusing to refer in this part to the concept of informal economy, while 25.2 is stated, there is no general definition of informal economy. (see 25.24, 25.26 and 25.30).
25.25	Consider beginning Part C with this paragraph.
