The treatment of ancillary activities has changed in the 1993 SNA Rev.1. The new treatment is described in paragraphs 5.37 – 5.40. Please indicate whether the description is sufficiently clear and comprehensive.

5.37	Does the last sentence mean that for every kind of centrally carried out ancillary activity a separate establishment should be made, classified into such an ISIC division, for which the nature of the rendered ancillary service to other establishments inside the enterprise is characteristic? Is then any important reason to distinguish between secondary and ancillary establishment?

5.39	Does it mean that an establishment should be divided between an ancillary establishment and another one providing services to outsiders? According to our old experience, almost in every ancillary activity of large enterprises, some part for sale to outsiders occurred.
