Importance of the classification

Time use statistics:

- the measurement and analysis of quality of life or general well-being
- a more comprehensive measurement of all forms of work, including unpaid and volunteer work
- emphasis on increasing visibility of women's work through better statistics on their contribution to the economy and the development of satellite accounts.¹


5.4.1 Percentage of time spent on unpaid domestic and care work, by sex, age group and location

Background

1995: Statistical Commission and Beijing Platform for Action requested the preparation of a classification of time-use activities

2000: revised version taking into account experiences from countries and recommendations from experts






Major changes from previous version



Employment

Difficult to differentiate in spite of the use of contextual variable on the purpose (contextual variable) of a productive activity

- The ILO program of pilot tests on the implementation of the 19th ICLS Resolution in labour force surveys to cast light on the best methods to make this distinction
- There is still the need for testing of this variable in the context of national TUS


