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


## **Status of SEEA Implementation**



- Global Assessment on Environmental Economic Accounting 2014
- 84 countries responded
- 54 currently have an SEEA programme
- Accounts most commonly compiled;
  - > Air Emissions, Material Flows, Energy
- Priorities accounts going forward;
  - Developed Countries: Energy, EPEA and EGSS
  - Developing Countries: Energy, Water and Environmental Taxes and Subsidies

• Joint strategy for SEEA Central Framework and Experimental Ecosystem Accounts

### **TARGETS FOR 2020**

- <u>100 countries</u> with ongoing programmes on SEEA Central Framework
- <u>50 countries</u> initiating work on SEEA Experimental Ecosystem Accounting

## **UNCEEA Work Programme**

- Work Programme 2017-2020 developed by the Bureau
- Takes a 5-pronged approach to global implementation based on the work streams outlined in the UNCEEA's Operational Guidelines\*
- For each work stream, Area Leads were identified:

1. Coordination and promotion	2. Methodological development	3. Development of databases	4. Implementation and statistical capacity building	5. Formulation of a statistical response to emerging policy issues

Area leads are responsible for; a) acting as a champion and providing leadership, b) developing more detailed work plans and strategies, and c) coordinating with other members of the UNCEEA



## UNCEEA roadmap 2017-2020: An overview

A. Coordination and promotion

- •Development and Publication of "Why SEEA?"
- Publication of "SEEA News and Notes"
- •Knowledge Platform: make training materials prominent & develop a community of practice
- •Global coordination of data work through UNCEEA

B1. Methodological Development (SEEA CF)

- Advancement of the SEEA CF Research Agenda
- Development of material in support of implementation including
  - Technical Notes
  - Training Materials
  - Guidance Documents

#### B2. Methodological Development (SEEA EEA)

- Technical Committee on SEEA EEA will be set up to update and publish the SEEA EEA manual by 2020
- Training materials and technical notes will also be developed



## **UNCEEA Roadmap**

#### C. Development of Databases

- Priority accounts will be identified
- Templates and distribution of responsibility will be agreed
- •SDMX capability
- •Global Data Structure Definition will be developed

#### D. Implementation and Statistical Capacity Building

- <u>Regional Approach</u> to be taken – Ask UNCEEA members to represent various regions
- Gap analysis based on regular global assessments
- Identify focus countries and undertake capacity building efforts
- Ensure coordination of international assistance through combined annual calendar of events

### E. Policy Applications and Emerging issues

- Workshop to be held to discuss: on the policy applications of the SEEA to support members and provide material to promote implementation efforts
- Develop a strategy for influencing existing statistical processes, e.g. the IAEG SDG and Climate Change
