## Adaptation to new/changing demands

- (New) data sources
- Standardization of processes
- Motivation of staff
- Additional financial resources EU grants

#### >Adaptation should be continuous



#### (New) data sources

- Administrative data long experiences
  - constant cooperation, agreements
  - helping to develop new sources
- Big data active in international projects
  - building trust (prices, job vacancies)
  - cooperation with the Information Commissioner (mobile phone data)
  - cooperation with the Faculty of Computer and Information Science



### Standardization of processes

- Centralization of supporting functions (data collection, dissemination, IT, registers, classifications, etc.)
- Development and/or implementation of standardised IT solutions (e.g. for data editing, e-reporting, seasonal adjustment)



### Motivation of staff

- Participation in international expert groups (EU, OECD, UNECE)
- Training



#### Additional financial resources

- SURS's budget ≈ 12 mio EUR
  93% national budget
  - 7% EU budget (EU grants) valuable resources for improvements
