Indonesian HIES (National Socioeconomic Survey= <i>Susen</i>) can accommodate around 49 indicators of SDGs, especially related to poverty, health, education, gender equality, hunger, water and sanitation, but it cannot accommodate district level indicators
5/12	2. Methodological validation and standard setting b. Develop guidance, standards and protocols on topics related to household surveys through commissioned work for example, quality assurance functions, use of Computer Assisted Personal Interview (CAPI), sensitive topics in household surveys, questionnaire design and testing protocol, data disaggregation, data triangulation, protocol for micro-data sharing including geo-referenced data, standard training curriculum and materials on household surveys and more.	Encourage UNSD to finalize and publish the revision of international standard classification for Households Expenditure: COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose) which has been discussed by the technical team and received inputs from countries in 2017. The revised COICOP will be a basis to classify household expenditure on goods and services in household surveys.
