## STATEMENT OF TURKEY

## **CLIMATE CHANGE STATISTICS**

Turkey supports the work of the Statistics Division in the development of a global set of climate change statistics and indicators, building upon all other processes in an effective and appropriate manner.

The list of activities presented by the Statistics Division for the development of the global set of climate change statistics and indicators are welcomed.
