Reducing the Gap between countries




- Integrate the efforts in conducting assessments, developing guidelines or training materials
- Sound methodologies and good practices in national statistical offices for the establishment, maintenance and improvement of the SBR.



Needs for new conceptual and classification schemes

- Guidelines on SBR and the Wiesbaden group efforts solve the most topics (ideal practices)
- Most countries don't meet the minimum requirements, this will open new needs to develop





methodologies to meet the particularities of different countries.

- The task team will use the assessment in developing new innovation tools to answer the needs of those emerging countries.
- Try to identify the special needs for those countries and propose a list of activities to build the capacities of human resources.
- Several scenarios can be found: weak legal legislation, good environment to start but lack of qualified human resources...etc.

Work plan



Global Assessment

- Conduct a global assessment on the status of implementation on SBRs in countries
- Review available assessments progress reports done by WG (53 countries) in 2016, 2018 and multilateral banks report.

Identifying priority areas

- Classification of the countries according to specific criteria
- identifying the priority areas for capacity buildings
- Selecting countries to be Pilot

Identifying available tools

- Pilot countries will be a basis for developing training tools and materials
- Countries with different cases will be selected.
