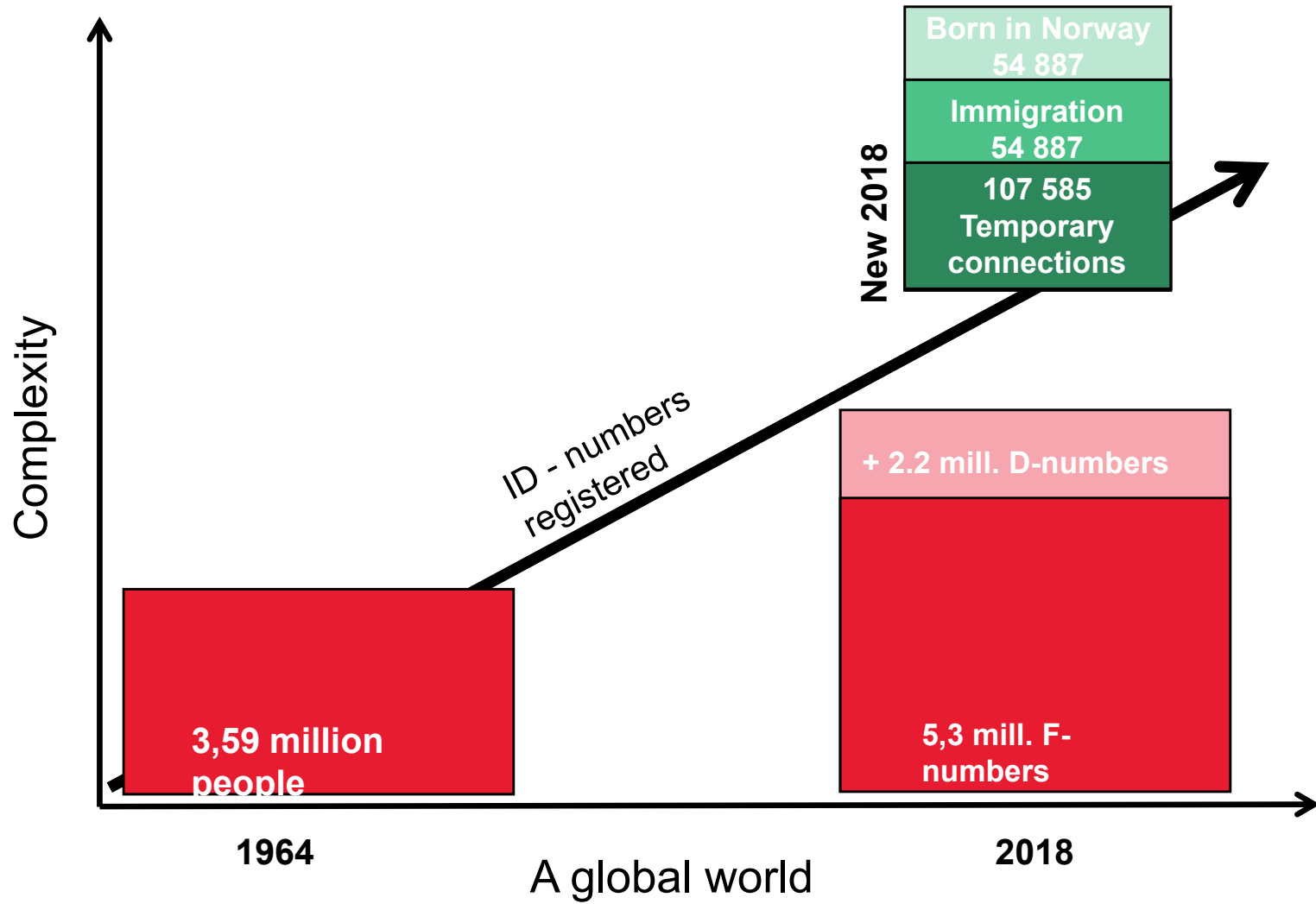

New National Registry Act

§ 1-1. The National population Registry

- *«There shall be one central population registry in Norway, called the National population Registry»*

New National Registry Act

§ 1-2. Purpose

- *«The purpose of the Act is to facilitate for a secure, correct and efficient registration of basic personal information about the person, including which persons who are resident in Norway. The National Registry Act make secure people who are obligated to be registered are issued an unique identification number. The Act shall contribute to the information in the National Registry can be used for the authorities task and public administration, science, statistics and to take care of the basic needs in the society.»*



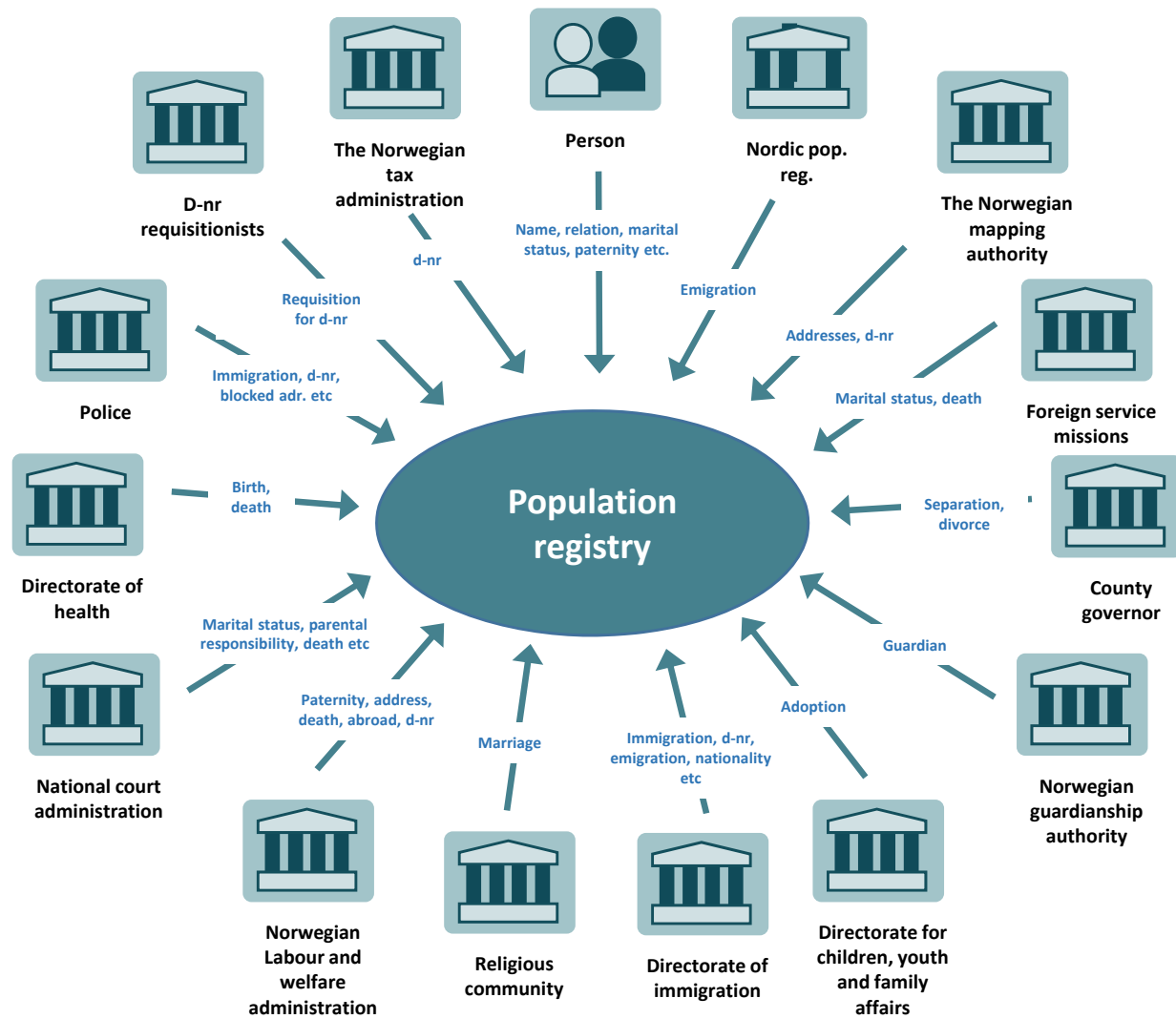

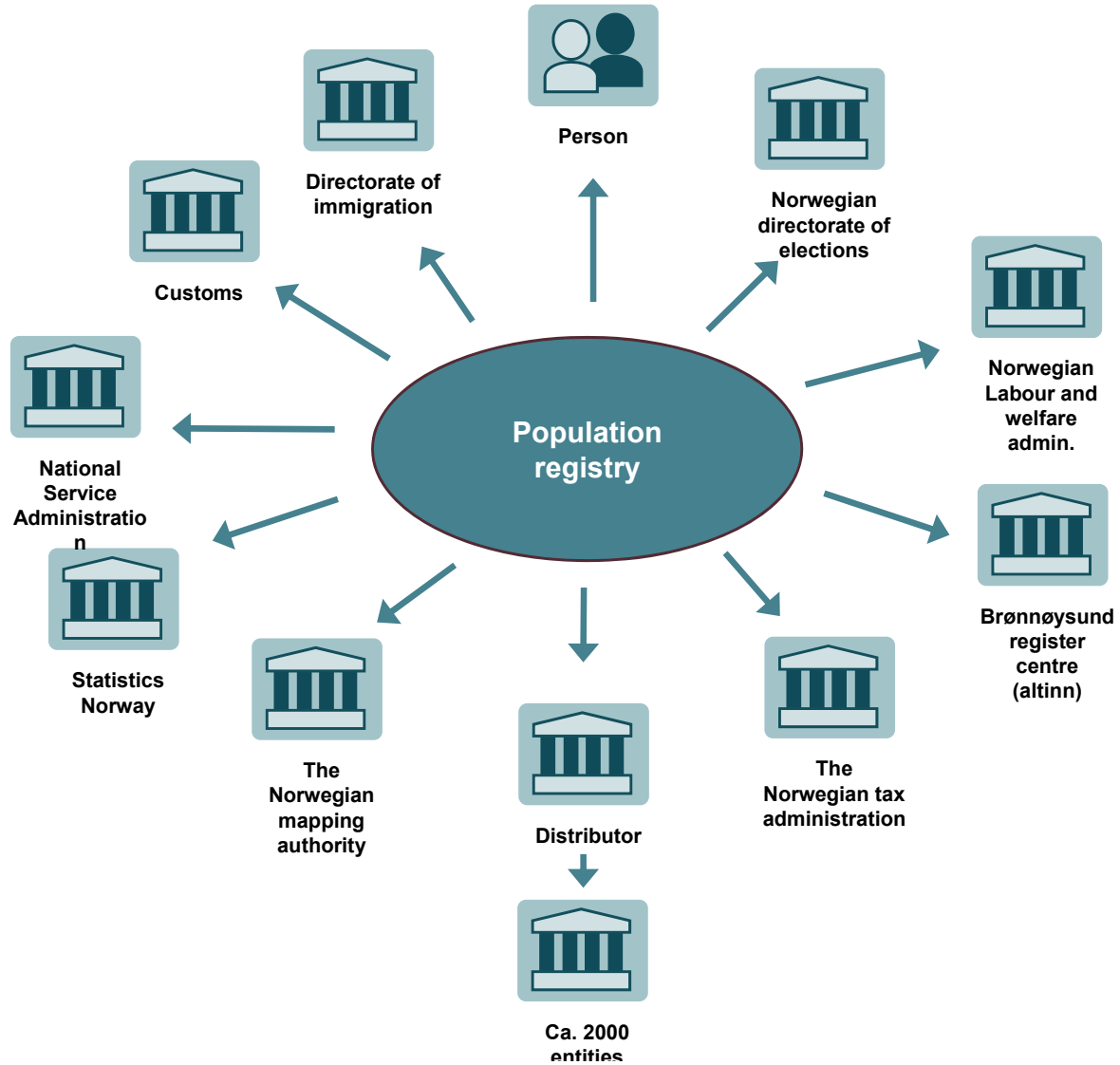
New National Registry Act

§ 2-1 Who shall be registered

«In the National Registry all persons who:

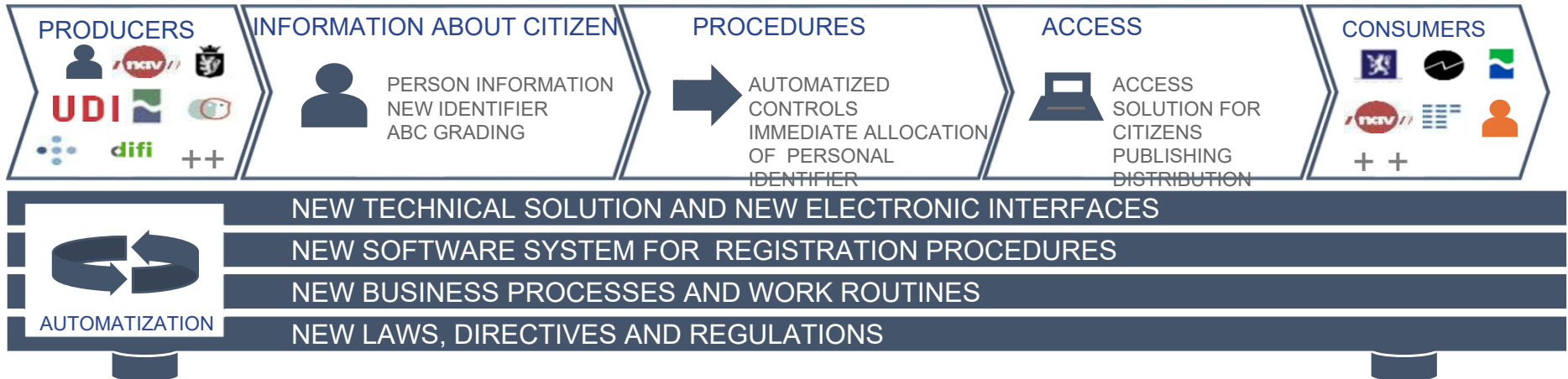
- a) is or has been resident in Norway*
- b) is born in Norway or*
- c) has been issued a f-number or a d-number»*





4 goals:

1. Safer management of identities and personal data
2. Improved quality of the registry data
3. More efficient registration procedures
4. A register that is user friendly and always available

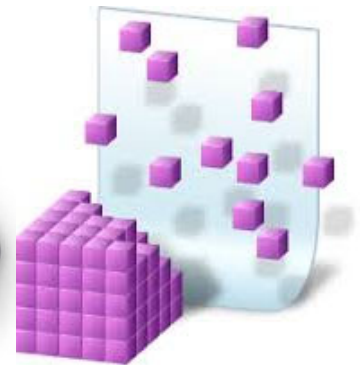

- We need to mirror the society, and leave no one behind

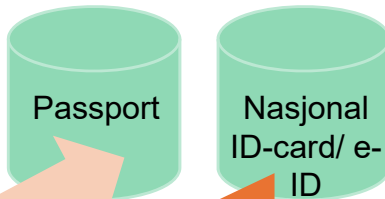

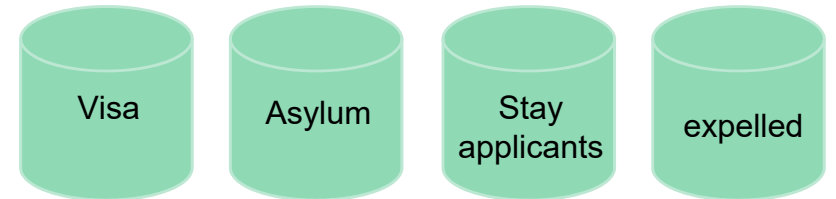
